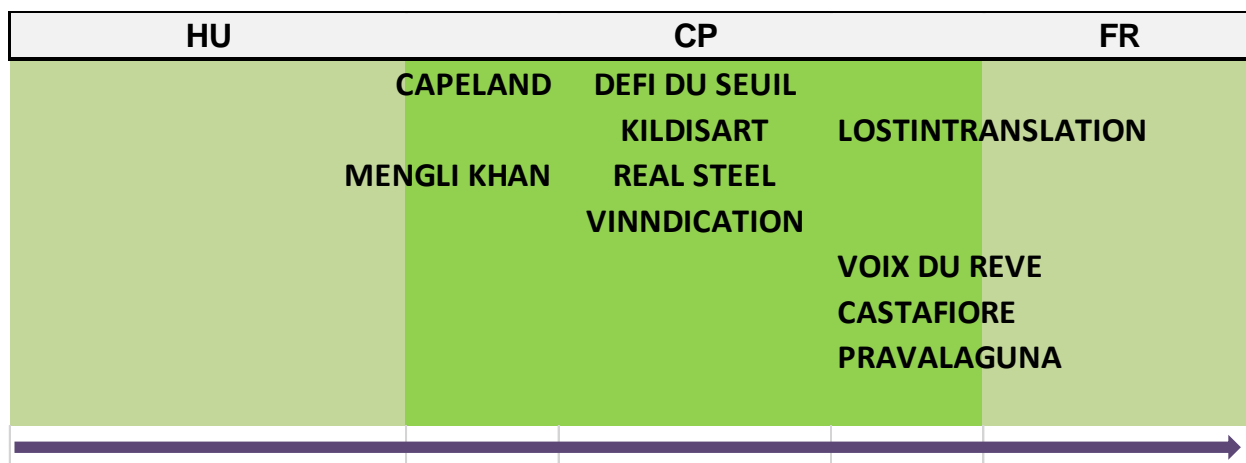

DEFI DU SEUIL (P Hobbs) – Hobbs has an excellent record with his last time out winners that start at 13/2 or less at the Festival (7/15 | 47% S/R – since 2003) and this lad looks to have a great record of enhancing those stats. When returning within 60 days of his last start Defi DS has a form line of 121111111 (8/9 – compared to 7451 off longer breaks) and with full marks on the trends (in what is proving to be a very strong trends race) then I'm happy to side with the 6yo here.

KILDISART (B Pauling) – This 7yo has been improving with each chase start and although he'll need to improve again to take this that's not difficult to see happening. He'll handle the ground (all 4 wins on ground with cut in it) and although he wasn't 100% fluent over these fences last time out the way he powered up the hill after the last was impressive and if he's still in there pitching come the home-straight he'll be one that's finishing stronger than plenty.

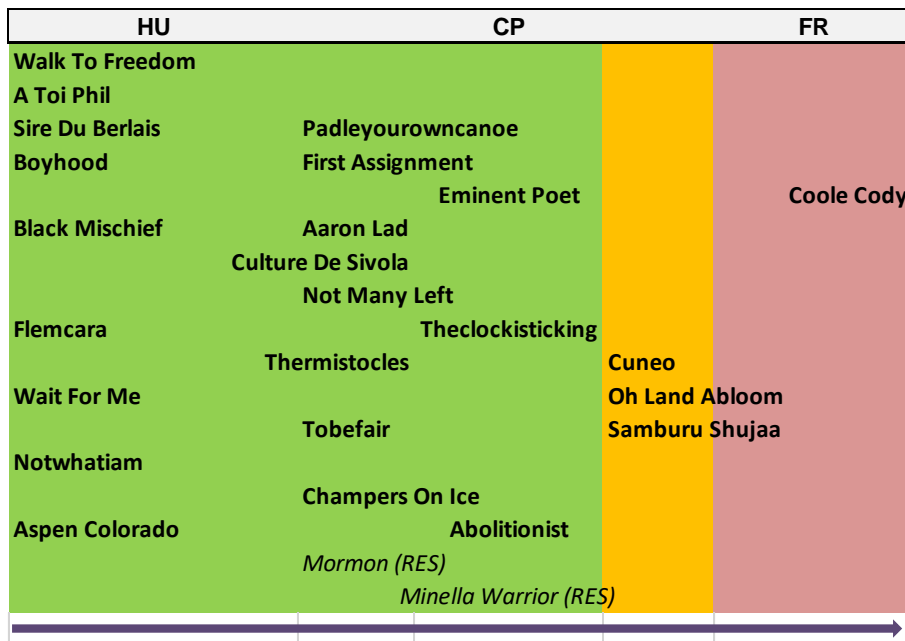

SAMBURU SHUJAA (P Hobbs) – *Has taken his form to another level since being stepped up to 3miles and as such he probably enters this with a few ponds still up his sleeve. Ground seems to come all the same to him, he's got no issue with a large field and he's surely a player in this.*

A TOI PHIL (G Elliott) – *I get the feeling they've dropped back to hurdles with this lad to take advantage of his lower mark over the smaller obstacles and it's safe to say he was ridden to qualify for this final last time out at Punchestown (as opposed to ridden to win the race), just being coaxed into 4th down the home-straight. He was a decent hurdler in his novice days (won a G2 at Leopardstown) and is an interesting player in this.*

CUNEO (H De Bromhead) – *A qualifier on the Gigginstown angle I highlighted in one of the members guides and that instantly draws me to him. He's unexposed, stays the trip, looks adaptable on the ground, handles large fields and Rachael Blackmore knows him well, I want him on side.*

FOOTPAD (W Mullins) – *The *ground has come for him here (form when soft or heavy in description = 1111F1131 (7/9) compared to 2F134243 (1/8) on quicker ground) and this looks a great spot for him to get his season back on track. He's untested over mid-range trips over here (did finish 3rd in a 3m G1 over hurdles though) but he is 1-1-2 over 2m3.5f trips in France and I don't see this 2m4.5f being an issue. For me his two defeats (from two starts) in Ireland this term have been down to the quick ground and a return to softer will definitely play to his strengths. If he can get anywhere close to the form which saw him win the Arkle last season then he'll prove very hard to beat.*

**it's officially Good to Soft (Soft in places)at the minute, changing from Soft, with rain forecast, and that should just keep it soft enough for him*

ROAD TO RESPECT (N Meade) – *I can see why they've dropped him back to this from the Gold Cup as although he ran a sound race in last years race (4th) it did look like he possibly didn't quite stay the gruelling trip. He won over this C&D two years ago in the Plate Chase and over fences over 2m3f-2m5f trips he is 1-4-1-1 and I'd have no concerns about the step back in trip here, given the fact he's generally a smooth traveller in his races. He's joint top rated on official ratings in this and his class should see him bang there come the business end.*

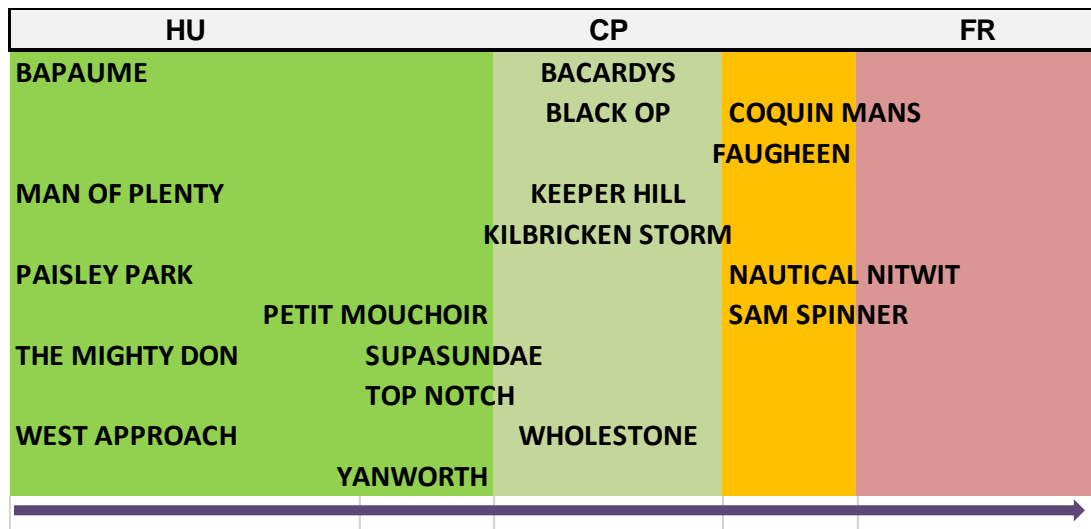
