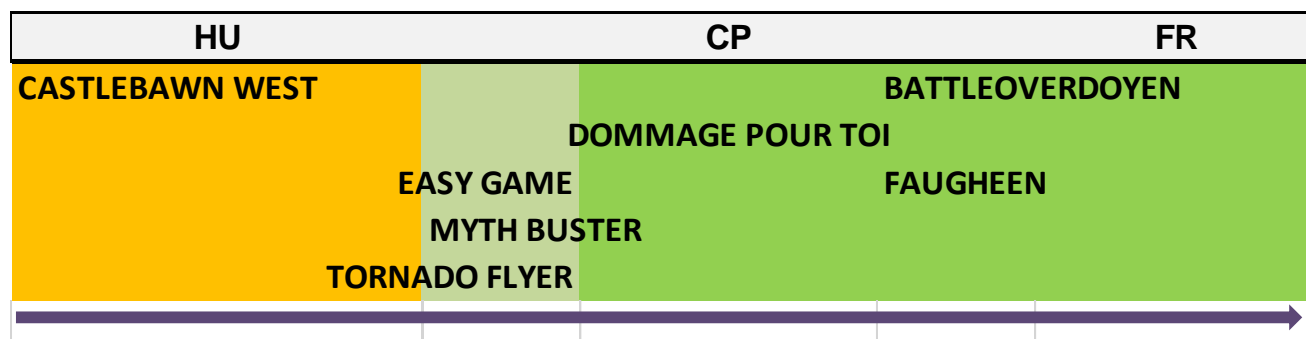

Conclusion/Selection(s)

BATTLEOVERDOYEN (G Elliott) – Happy to take on Faugheen with this lad, who has only been beaten once in his seven career starts (when not quite handling the undulations at Cheltenham in the Ballymore). The drop back in trip shouldn't pose a problem and his proven G1 jumping form (which only Faugheen has from the rest of the field) should pull him through here.

EASY GAME does, to a certain extent, appeal as well and he could make his presence felt. His previous G1 form (8-7) does concern me a shade, however, but there was plenty to like about his chase debut last time out over CD.

DELTA WORK (G Elliott) – This looks between the two market rivals Delta Work and Kemboy, with the ground just about swaying me towards the Elliott horse. On Yielding to Soft or quicker he is 21121111 (compared to 33341342 on softer ground) and he clearly loves the 3m Leopardstown trip (2 from 2, both Grade 1's).

Nothing at all against KEMBOY and I would be surprised if something other than he or Delta Work won this, I may even dutch the pair.

PRESENTING PERCY I'm happy to take on at G1 level until he proves me otherwise (1/6 at G1 level). He's been beaten both previous starts at the track as well. I'd just want to be seeing him land another G1 before seriously considering him a solid G1 player.
