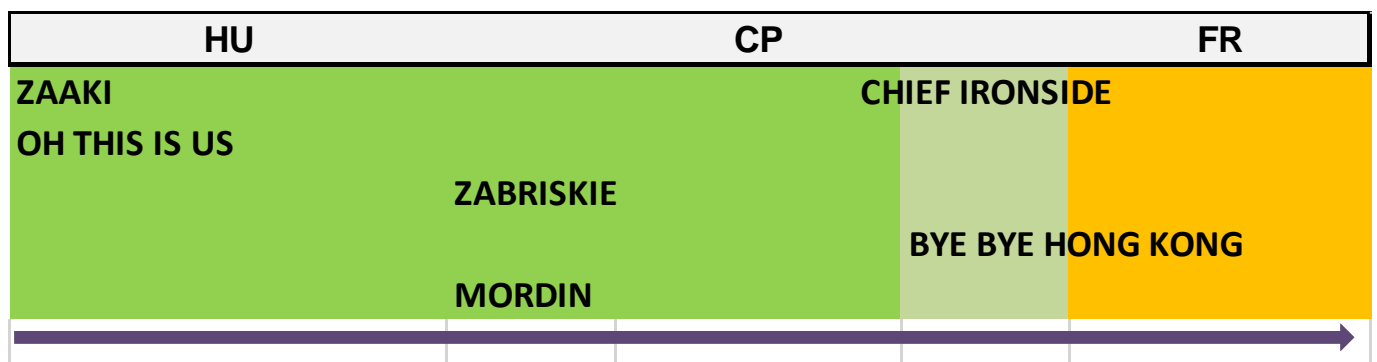

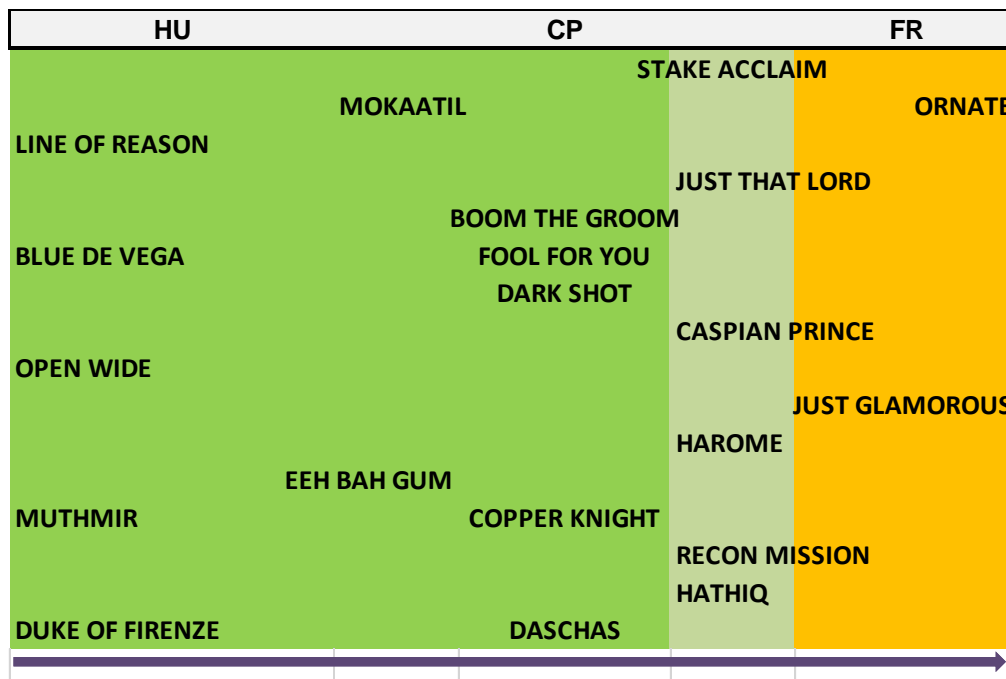

EEH BAH GUM (T Easterby) – Good chance this lad still has more to offer after only 15 starts and these conditions are probably optimum...straight 5f | Good or quicker | DSLR 30 or less...where he is 84121111 (5/8, 2p – all 5 career wins). Jamie Gormley's 3lb claim is a big help (and jockey is 1 from 1 on him) and the horse does run particularly well in the May-June period (114811).

DARK SHOT (S Dixon) – The 6yo been running well this season in 3 starts without quite getting his head in-front and given that he's 2-5-2 at this track, including a short-head 2nd in this from 1lb higher 2 years ago, you'd have to think he'll be running another big race at a track he enjoys.

ORNATE (D Griffiths) – Probably just been outclassed on his last two starts but this is a more realistic target and if he gets into a decent stride from his low draw he could be hard to peg back. A straight five on decent ground will suit and he looks decent value at lofty odds.

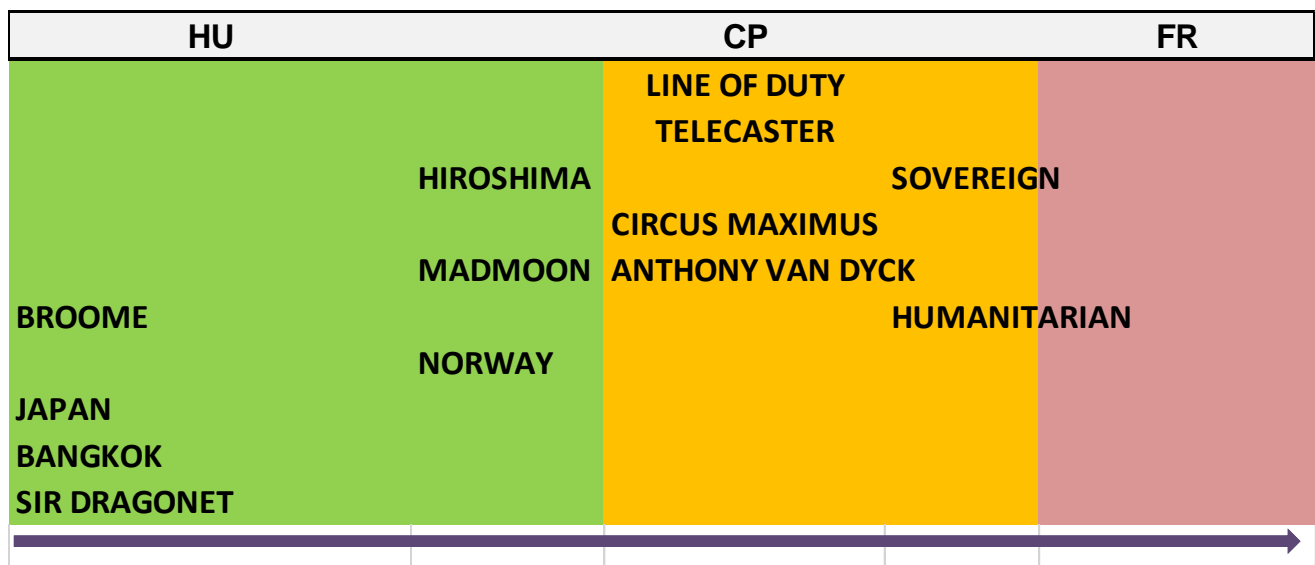

BREATH CAUGHT (I Williams) – The Ian Williams yard have finally started to hit a bit of form and the gelding operation mixed with this being his first start for Williams could well bring about improvement in this 4yo. Connections clearly think the horse has stamina in him as he's entered for the Northumberland Plate and if that is the case then Jim Crowley may be able to stretch them off the front end and use the horses stamina to hang on for the win.

GRANDEE (R Fell) – The move to Roger Fell seems to have rejuvenated this 5yo and OR 90 does look like a mark he can be competitive from (has finished second off OR 100). He ran in this race off 12lb higher last year but not only was that a tough mark for him to be winning from he was also drawn 19 of 19 and that's a tough place to win from (widest stall is 0/22 last 22 renewals). He looks to have a much more realistic chance this time round and he also comes into the race in much better form.
