## Ben's Thoughts

**TIS MARVELLOUS (12.50 Ascot)** won this race from a 3lb lower mark 2 years ago but he's won from a higher mark in handicap company than what he runs from here and does look to have his Prime Conditions to attack - **C2 or less | OR 107 or less | June-Sept = 341120010412 (4/12, 4p - all 4 career wins)**...Hcp PC = Hcps | **June & later | OR 103 or less = 3412104 (2/7, 3p)**. I feel Hollie Doyle got tactics a little wrong on the 7yo last time out but the small field won't have helped her much that day there should be cover for the horse here with a couple of pace horses drawn close to him (in stalls 1 & 5 and possibly 4 – he is in stall 2). Also worth noting the **Ascot record of Clive Cox since 2018 in C2 or less races with his horses that start in the top 4 in the market...13/37 | 35% S/R | +£86.94 BFLSP – W&P 20/37 | 54% S/R – 100% above exp.**

**INDIANAPOLIS (1.25 Ascot)** is a hefty 10lbs below his last and highest winning mark and he's been running better than the bare form suggests on recent starts. He won at this meeting two years ago over the 1m4f trip and there's been enough in his two starts over and around 2m to suggest he can land a race at this trip.

Providing the rain stays away (or at least stays away in enough volume to not change the ground down past Good to Soft) I'd also look to have a crack at **HOCHFELD** in this race as well. He will almost certainly get free reign of things on the front end here and he could be hard to catch if he gets into a rhythm. He's been running well this season and was unlucky not to land the Northumberland Plate in June (0.5L 2<sup>nd</sup>) and go even closer than his 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Chester Cup in May (got no run in the home-straight). I just wouldn't want things to get too testing for him.

**VINTAGER (2.35 Ascot)** was undone by the small field at Ayr last time out (he's 0/6, 0p in field of 7or less) but he still recorded a solid speed figure and remains on a winnable mark based on his very best form (has won off as high as OR 102 and placed off OR 110). He's unbeaten when meeting with today's conditions - **C2 or below | OR 102 or less | June-Aug | Fields of 8+ = 111 (3/3 - all 3 career wins)** – and the wide draw should prove no barrier as 3 of the last 5 winners of this were also drawn in the widest stall.

I'd be a little concerned for VINTAGER should there be a lot of rain at Ascot and would probably be looking to back **RAISING SAND** in this one as well, as he'll be fine with softening of the ground.

**CAPTAIN JAMESON (6.25 Ayr)** has been a while between drinks but he's been running well recently and he clearly bumped into a well-handicapped rival last time out, with the winner that day going on to score comfortably next time out from a 7lb higher mark. He gets Prime Conditions to shoot for here - **C4 & below | OR 82 or less | NOT seasonal debut = 22532345231113 (3/14, 8p - all 3 career wins)** – and Jason Hart back in the saddle is a positive as the jockey has ridden him to all 3 of his career wins. He's now racing off his lowest ever mark but his speed figures this year don't suggest he's regressed all that much (indeed he recorded his second best speed figure ever at Catterick in May) and trainer John Quinn does do well at Ayr under the following... **J Quinn | Ayr 6f-1m trips | C4 or less | DSLR 45 or less = 19/73 | 26% S/R | +£83.69 BFLSP – W&P 46/73 | 63% S/R – 49% above exp**...Captain Jameson qualifying on that angle here.
