Ben's Thoughts

THE BIG HOUSE (4.25 Catterick) is one I want to take a crack at. He generally saves his best for Catterick and he posted some solid enough efforts so far this season despite yet to meet with his Prime Conditions (**OR 62 or less | LH Hcps | July-Sept = 1113321 (4/7, 3p – all 4 career wins – all 7 runs came at Catterick or Thirsk)**) conditions he gets here. He's overcome a wide draw over this CD previously so that isn't a concern and the Adrian Nicholls yard are potentially coming into a bit of form, with their last 5 runners (today's runner at Nottingham not included as yet to run) returning a form line of 93232 (71% PRB).

In the second division of the 7f handicap I like the look of **CHICKENFORTEA (5.00 Catterick)**. It's been a while since he visited the winners enclosure but his last effort (a 3rd over CD) suggested he can still run to form when meeting with his Prime Conditions (**OR 65 or less | Jul-Sept | C5 or less Hcps worth 3K or less = 323611 (2/6, 3p - both career wins - both wins came at Catterick)**). The Declan Carroll yard are also in solid form at present, with 16-day stats of...3/15, 6p (57% PRB), their last 5 runners returning a form line of 20133. There isn't a lot of pace in this race so he should manage to get a good early racing position from stall 7.

LYNDON B (7.35 Sandown) has been slipping down the weights this season but he wasn't beaten far at Bath last time out and is now in his Prime Months with Prime Conditions to attack (**C3 or less Hcps | OR 90 or less | July-Aug = 131 (2/3, 1p – both career wins)**). He's won over this CD previously and should get the decent pace he needs to aim at here.

ALSVINDER is definitely interesting in the 1.50 at Catterick as he looks to back up his win at Ayr last time out but I'm concerned by his draw in stall 10 and the fact he's only won 1 of his 14 previous starts in fields of 11+. Must be a worry that he won't get to the front without a battle here (8 of his 11 wins have come off the front end) and that just tempers my enthusiasm enough to be erring on the side of caution at time of writing.
