Ben's Thoughts

VENTURA FLAME (2.40 Beverley) has been running well this season and the form of her close 5th at Hamilton last time out has been boosted since, with the winner – Soul Seeker – landing a C3 since, the 3rd – Jordan Electrics – winning at Ayr on Monday and the 4th – Sound Of Iona – going close in a valuable C4 at Musselburgh on Sunday. She gets Prime Conditions to attack here - turf | 5f | C4 or less | OR 80 or less | DSLR 21 or less | 11 or less runners = 2142341612112 (5/13, 5p - all 5 career wins) – has a win and a place from her 3 starts previous starts at the track and should get a good early position from stall 5, with a couple of hold-up runners drawn on her inside.

Tom Dascombe doesn't waste his time making the trek over to Beverley with horses with a similar profile to COMMONSENSICAL (3.15 Beverley) and he's of interest as he looks to back up his Bath win from last time out. Just as interesting is the fact that Jane Elliott keeps the ride as the pair have an excellent record together when teaming up with last time out winners under the following...Dascombe/J Elliott | LTO Winners | Turf | C3 or less = 10/15 | 67% S/R | +£53.31

BFLSP – W&P 11/15 | 73% S/R...with that angle producing the following form line in 2021 so far...11112. The visor worked wonders last time out and hopefully Elliott can grab the lead here (good chance of that) and lead them a merry dance from the front.

PROUD ARCHI (3.59 Beverley) was undone by the softened ground and an application of a visor last time out but this better ground and a return to cheek-pieces (3-2-2 with CP's on) will be more to his liking, especially with his Prime Conditions to gun for - G/S+ | 7f-7.5f | OR 82 or below | Apr-Aug | Flat fairly sharp/sharp tracks (Thirsk, Bev, Muss...) = 5/13, 4p - all 5 career wins. There are a couple of speed horses in this to drag him into the race and he can make his play late in the day as he tries to break his long losing streak.

AMALFI DOUG and GET OUT THE GATE (7.25) were also of potential interest at Perth but there is rain forecast for the track so I just want to see how that plays out before making any decision on whether or not to back either of them.
