

17:15 KEMPTON (A.W) - 1m - FILLIES' NOVICE STAKES (GBB RACE) (DIV I) (5) 2YO, Class 5

RUBINA ROSE - No Rating.* March Filly out of Elas Ruby by Nathaniel * Marco Botti/Jack Mitchell, Previous Runs 1, Cost Unknown. Second foal, dam 8f AW Two-Year-Old/10f turf Listed winner (RPR 101). Sire winner of the King George & Eclipse. No AW Speed Figure yet. A modest fifth over 7f on debut at Newmarket but the sixth has won a modest event since.

PEACEFUL NIGHT - No Rating.* April Filly out of Concordia by New Approach * Charlie & Mark Johnston/Jason Hart, Previous Runs 2, Cost Unknown. Ninth foal, half-sister to 6 winners including Polarisation (6f-2m including as a Two-Year-Old/Australian Group 1, 107), Trumpet Man (2m including AW, 105) and Clearly (8f GB AW/10f Australia Listed, 95), dam French 11.2f winner. Sire five-time Group 1 winner over 7-12f as a as a Two to Three-Year-Old, excellent sire including Dawn Approach, Masar and Talent. No AW Speed Figure yet. Confusing messages on paper and struggled over this trip in a 3-runner race last time out at Yarmouth when allowed an easy lead.

ROADWAY (USA) - No Rating.* May Filly out of Love Me Only by Quality Road * John & Thady Gosden/Robert Havlin, Previous Runs 1, Cost Unknown. Eighth foal, half-sister to winners Storm The Stars (10f-12f including Group 2, RPR 118) and Prairie Wings (US 9f dirt), dam unraced. Sire top-class 7-9f winner as a Three to Four-Year-Old, 6f winner as a Two-Year-Old, family of Bahri, sire of Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf winner Hootenanny. No AW Speed Figure yet. Never put in the race on debut, running to market expectations and the yards second start Juveniles are 0 from 9 since the beginning of October.

MOVIE STAR LOOKS - No Rating.* Unraced Filly out of Garanciere by Cracksman * Clive Cox/Rossa Ryan, Previous Runs 0, Cost 70,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Tenth foal, half-sister to 6 winners including I Love Me (Group-placed 7f Two-Year-Old, RPR 108), Ningara (8f-12f including AW Two-Year-Old/Qatar Listed, 99) & Doubling Dice (12f, 90), dam French 9f winner. Sire 8f winner as Two-Year-Old, champion Three-Year-Old colt & four time Group 1 winner as a Three to Four-Year-Old, including dual Champion Stakes. No AW Speed Figure yet.

HUMANKIND (IRE) - No Rating.* February Filly out of Ama by Frankel * Sir Michael Stoute/Jim Crowley, Previous Runs 1, Cost Unknown. Eighth foal, closely related to 7f Two-Year-Old winner Aeonian (RPR 98) & 1½f winner Wanderwell (82), half-sister to 5 winners including Lunar Maria (8f including Listed, 93) & Festival Day (7f Two-Year-Old, 86), dam second 7f/8f both runs. Sire Highest-ever rated racehorse by RPRs, unbeaten 10-time Group 1 winner. No AW Speed Figure yet. A daughter of Frankel with several winners in her family was never involved after a slow start at Doncaster when relatively unfancied, she more than hinted at ability by the finish and can be expected to improve. The Two - Year-Old progeny of Frankel have shown a poor record on debut so far this year but his non-debutantes are currently operating at just over 40% and those making their second start are currently operating at just over 41% although still 0 from 4 on the AW. In the past Sir Michael has been profitable to follow with similarly profiled runners.

RAINBOW SKY - No Rating.* Unraced Filly out of Best Terms by Sea The Stars * Charlie Appleby/James Doyle, Previous Runs 0, Cost 1,500,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Sixth foal, sister to 7f-12f winner Star Terms who won twice as a Two-Year-Old over 7f before going on to win once more in Listed Company over 12f, RPR 107), half-sister to 3 winners including Fresh Terms (10f including Listed, 97) & Mayaas

(7f as a Two-Year-Old/7½f as a Three-Year-Old, 92), dam had Two-Year-Old form figures of 1,1,1,1,5, her first 3 wins were over 5f including in Group 2 Company before winning over 6f again in Group 2 Company, 114) struggled thereafter. Sire Group 2 8f Two-Year-Old, exceptional 6-time Group 1 winner as a Three-Year-Old, including Guineas/Derby/Arc. No AW Speed Figure yet. Has a very inviting pedigree and It would be disappointing if this expensive purchase wasn't good enough win this on debut.

OLYMPIC QUEST - No Rating.* Unraced Filly out of Olympic Runner by Australia * Clive Cox/John Fahy, Previous Runs 0, Cost Unknown. Third foal, closely related to Italian 5f/6f winner Olympic Eagle (RPR 74), dam 5f AW Two-Year-Old winner (85). Sire Won Group 3 as a Two-Year-Old, outstanding Three-Year-Old, including Derby & Irish Derby. No AW Speed Figure yet.

STAR CHILD - Rated 62, **AW Rating Rank 1, AW Speed Rank *** April Filly out of Spicy Dal by Gleneagles * Archie Watson/Luke Morris, Previous Runs 1, Cost Unknown. Fifth foal, closely related to winners Sanitiser (6f-10f including as a Two-Year-Old.AW, RPR 97) & Snatty Dancer (Danish 10f-10.7f), dam 9f winner (Listed placed 10f, 92). Sire Top-class Two-Year-Old, including National Stakes, thrice Group 1 winner as a Three-Year-Old, including dual 2000 Guineas outstanding family. 85 AW Speed Figure. She is the only runner with any AW experience and that was a disappointing tenth of 12 here over 7f last month finishing over 12L behind Whispering Dream who won here earlier this week.

KHINJANI - No Rating.* March Filly out of Kandahari by Sir Percy * Ed Walker/Ross Coakley, Previous Runs 2, Cost Unknown. Second foal, sister to 7f and 8f (Listed) Two-Year-Old winner Kawida (stays 12f, RPR 106), dam 9.4f winner (68), sister to 10f/12f winner Apparatchika. Sire won Dewhurst and Derby, second in 2,000 Guineas and gets some decent Two-Year-Olds, progeny progress. No AW Speed Figure yet. Improved on her debut run to finish 2¾ second of 11 at Nottingham and just about sets the standard, albeit not too high.

SONEMOS (IRE) - No Rating.* May Filly out of Adroit by Vadamos * Kevin Philippart De Foy/Daniel Muscutt, Previous Runs 2, Cost 40,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Third foal, half-sister to Bell I Am (RPR 80) who was placed in Listed Company over 6f and only career win came over 5.7f as a Two-Year-Old, dam 7f winner (80), closely related to 6f Group 3 Two-Year-Old winner Princess Iris out of 7f Two-Year-Old Group 3 winner Sire progressive, won over 12f but developed into top-class miler, family of high-class Val Royal. No AW Speed Figure yet.

URBAN DECAY - No Rating.* Unraced Filly out of Main Desire by Frankel * Michael Bell/David Egan, Previous Runs 0, Cost Unknown. First foal, dam 5f winner (including Two-Year-Old/Listed, RPR 101). Sire Highest-ever rated racehorse by RPRs, unbeaten 10-time Group 1 winner. No AW Speed Figure yet. As mentioned before, the Two-Year-Old progeny have shown a very poor record on debut in the last couple of years with just 6 winners from 77 runners in 2021 and so far in 2022 and 0 from 16 when making their debut on the AW, that strike rate has deteriorated this year with just 1 winning debutante from the 33 to have run.

CONCLUSION

RAINBOW SKY cost connections 1,500,000 Guineas as a Yearling and has a very inviting pedigree with a good mixture of stamina on the sire's side being by Sea The Stars and speed, out of a dam whose Two-Year-Old form figures read 1,1,1,1,5 , her first 3 wins were over 5f including in Group 2 Company before winning over 6f again in Group 2 Company, so It would be disappointing she wasn't good enough win this on debut. **KHINJANI** just about sets the standard, albeit not too high.

ROADWAY is worth monitoring in the market but the yards second start Juveniles are 0 from 9 since the beginning of October. The main danger in my opinion would appear to be **HUMANKIND**, who more than hinted at ability on debut, doesn't have much to find with **Khinjani** and can be expected to improve being by Frankel, whose Two-Year-Old progeny have shown a poor record on debut so far this year but his non-debutantes are currently operating at just over 40% and those making their second start are currently operating at just over 41%, although still 0 from 4 on the AW but in the past Sir Michael Stoute has been profitable to follow with similarly profiled runners but you would have to be concerned slightly by his current record with Two-Year-Olds.
