## LINGFIELD (A.W) - 1m - IT'S TIME TO TURN TO TALKSPORT EBF FILLIES' NOVICE STAKES (GBB RACE) (DIV I) (5) 2YO, Class 5

CHOISYA - No Rating.\* Unraced Filly out of Fragrancy by Night Of Thunder \* Simon & Ed Crisford/Kevin Stott, Previous Runs 0, Cost Unknown. Tenth foal, closely related to 10.3f/12f winner Flower Of Love (including AW, RPR 85), half-sister to 4 winners including Pelerin who was 2 from 2 on the AW over 7f-9f at Kempton as a Two-Year-Old and later at Dundalk in Listed Company as a Three-Year-Old, 107), Masarah who won over 6f on the AW as a Two-Year-Old/9f turf later 100) & Base Note (10f/12f AW, 99), dam was an 9f-10f winner including as a Two-Year-Old on the AW at Lingfield, 106). Sire 6f Listed winner as a Two-Year-Old, top miler as a Three-Year-Old-4, won 2,000 Guineas & Lockinge. No AW Speed Figure yet. Looks bred to be a decent AW Two-Year-Old and the yard are 3 from their last 8 Two-Year-Old debutantes. Advice: Interesting newcomer

MNEEFAH (IRE) - Rated 78, AW Rating Rank 4, AW Speed Rank 3\* April Filly out of Kitty Matcham by Caravaggio \* George Boughey/David Egan, Previous Runs 2, Cost €75,000 as a Two-Year-Old, 62,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Tenth foal, sister to 6½f winner Aratori (RPR 90), half-sister to 5 winners including Sam Missile (9f-16f, rated 98), Marciano (6f-9f including AW rated 86) and Breeze rated 75 over 9f on the AW, dam 6f/7f Two-Year-Old winner (including Group 2, rated 105), Sire bullet sprinter, unbeaten Two-Year-Old, including The Phoenix Stakes, won Commonwealth Cup as a Three-Year-Old, from smart US family. 92 AW Speed Figure. Advice: Hard to recommend unless significant market support.

WINTER MOON (IRE) - No Rating.\* Unraced Filly out of Piscean Dream by Roaring Lion \* Andrew Balding/Joshua Bryan, Previous Runs 0, Cost 45,000 Guineas as a Yearling. First foal, dam unraced half-sister to French 7½f Two-Year-Old/US 9f Grade 1 winner Amorama (dam of French 11f Group 2 winner Ampere), French 9f Listed winner Table Ronde and Japanese 10f Listed winner Uncoiled out of 12f/13f winner Sire Son of Kitten's Joy, 4 times Group 1 winner, placed in Racing Post Trophy & Derby. No AW Speed Figure yet. The yard are 0 from 24 with their Two-Year-Old debutantes since the start of October. Advice: Happy to watch.

PRINCESS NIYLA - No Rating.\* Unraced Filly out of Coillte Cailin by Night Of Thunder \* Hugo Palmer/Pierre-Louis Jamin, Previous Runs 0, Cost 65,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Second foal, dam a 7 times AW winner the highest off a mark of 90, winning over 9.4f/10f (RPR 99). Sire 6f Listed winner as a Two-Year-Old, top miler as a Three-Year-Old-4, won 2,000 Guineas & Lockinge. No AW Speed Figure yet. Dam was a decent AW runner but unraced as a Two-Year-Old. The yard have only ever had 3 winning Two-Year-Old debutantes on the AW. Advice: Happy to watch.

**RUBINA ROSE** - Rated 64, AW Rating Rank 5, AW Speed Rank 5\* March Filly out of Elas Ruby by Nathaniel \* Marco Botti/Jimmy Quinn, Previous Runs 2, Cost Unknown. Second foal, dam 9f AW Two-Year-Old/10f turf Listed winner (RPR 101). Sire winner of the King George & Eclipse. 84 AW Speed Figure. **Advice: Looks like one for next year once handicapping.** 

SUNSET POINT - Rated 84, AW Rating Rank 1, AW Speed Rank 1\* April Filly out of Hidden Gold by Dubawi \* Charlie Appleby/Jim Crowley, Previous Runs 2, Cost Unknown. Third foal, sister to winners Creative Flair (7f-10f including as a Two-Year-Old/UAE Group 2, RPR 111) and Secret Victory (9f/8.6f AW, 94), dam 10f-16f winner (including 13f AW Listed, 108). Sire unbeaten Two-Year-Old, including National Stakes, won Irish Guineas & Jacques le Marois as a Three-Year-Old, exceptional sire. 97 AW Speed Figure. Had a wide trip on her debut at Kempton over 7f and run no race, was better drawn last time out, again at Kempton but stepped up to 8f and saved ground around the inside and although looking a little one-paced in the closing stages but it was still a decent run and this sharper

track may suit. She looks the part on paper and Charlie Appleby is currently operating at around 42% with his third-start Two-Year-Olds in Non-Handicaps. **Advice: Interesting but Jockey/Trainer record isn't compelling.** 

MEXICALI ROSE - No Rating.\* January Filly out of Apache Storm by Zoffany \* Ralph Beckett/Rossa Ryan, Previous Runs 1, Cost 50,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Second foal, dam 6f-7f AW winner (including as a Two-Year-Old on the AW at Kempton and Southwell (fibresand), RPR 95). Sire top-class 6-7f Two-Year-Old, including Group 1 Phoenix Stakes, high-class over 9f as a Three-Year-Old, good source of Two-Year-Old's. No AW Speed Figure yet. Sets the standard on her debut run at Newmarket and she went into My Tracker with the notes "showed up nicely on debut and should improve, possibly over further". Advice: One of the more likely winners but yard's Two-Year-Olds haven't been consistent enough for me at the likely odds.

**TULEKYA** - No Rating.\* Unraced Filly out of Kuna Yala by Wootton Bassett \* Kevin Philippart De Foy/Richard Kingscote, Previous Runs 0, Cost 70,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Second foal, dam German 8.7f winner. Sire unbeaten champion Two-Year-Old in France, from fast and tough family, sire of multiple Group 1 winner Almanzor. No AW Speed Figure yet. The yard have only had 2 winning Two-Year-Old debutantes so far this year and none since August. **Advice: Watch** 

STAR CHILD - Rated 82, AW Rating Rank 2, AW Speed Rank 3\* April Filly out of Spicy Dal by Gleneagles \* Archie Watson/Luke Morris, Previous Runs 2, Cost Unknown. Fifth foal, closely related to winners Sanitiser (6f-10f including as a Two-Year-Old on the AW, RPR 97) & Snatty Dancer (Danish 10f-10.7f), dam 9f winner (Listed placed 10f, 92). Sire Top-class Two-Year-Old, including National Stakes, thrice Group 1 winner as a Three-Year-Old, including dual 2000 Guineas outstanding family. 92 AW Speed Figure. Put in an eye-catching "non-trying" run on debut when denied a clear run over 7f at Kempton and then benefited from a prominent pitch and outran her odds when stepped up to 8f again at Kempton, She should be a winning Two-Year-Old on pedigree and could be dangerous if allowed an easy lead, I always concerned with runners from this yard qualifying for Handicaps but they generally do well here although I would have preferred a longer break between runs. Advice Lively Outsider.

MISTRAL STAR - No Rating.\* Unraced Filly out of Shirocco Star by Frankel \* Hughie Morrison/Jason Hart, Previous Runs 0, Cost Unknown. Fourth foal, closely related to 10f-12½f winner Telecaster (including Group 2, RPR 117), half-sister to winners Al Suhail (7f/9f including as a Two-Year-Old/Group 2, 117) & Starcaster (9f-12½f including Listed, 96), dam 9f Two-Year-Old winner/Oaks & Irish Oaks second (114) out of 12f winner Sire Highest-ever rated racehorse by RPRs, unbeaten 10-time Group 1 winner, from fine family. No AW Speed Figure yet. The newcomers from this yard are often better for a run but her pedigree certainly catches the eye and likely one for further next year. Advice: Market informative.

SPRING FEVER - Rated 80, AW Rating Rank 3, AW Speed Rank 2\* March Filly out of Primevere by Dubawi \* John & Thady Gosden/Kieran O'Neill, Previous Runs 1, Cost Unknown. Fifth foal, half-sister to 10f/12f winner Bartzella (including Listed, RPR 105) and 7f-10f winner Sucellus (including AW Two-Year-Old, 95), dam 9f-10f winner (including as a Two-Year-Old/AW/Listed, RPR 110). Sire unbeaten Two-Year-Old, including National Stakes, won Irish Guineas & Jacques le Marois as a Three-Year-Old. 94 AW Speed Figure. She was niggled along at various stages on debut at Kempton over 8f and looked in more need of the experience than her stablemate who won the race. She should come on for that run but I doubt if she is a future stable star. Advice: Interesting.

MARION OF ELMSTONE - No Rating.\* Unraced Filly out of Ever Love by Golden Horn \* John Best & Karen Jewell/Hayley Turner, Previous Runs 0, Cost 25,000 Guineas as a Foal. Seventh foal, half-sister

to winners Ode To Evening (6f as a Two-Year-Old/10f, RPR 107), Torchlighter (6f-10f, 105), Top Mission (7f on the AW, 92) & Shamekh (7f, 79), dam was a champion Brazilian filly, won Brazilian 1,000/Oaks. Sire 9f Two-Year-Old winner, champion Three-Year-Old & horse of the year, won Derby, Eclipse, Irish Champion Stakes & Arc. No AW Speed Figure yet. **Advice: Look elsewhere**.

## **CONCLUSION**

Of the five past renewals of this race, all bar one was won by a runner drawn in the outside stalls, last year it was split in to 2 divisions with stalls 12 of 12, and 9 of 9 winning, in 2020, again split in to 2 races, with stalls 3 of 10 and 9 of 10 winning and in 2019 stall 10 of 10 won. MEXICALI ROSE and SUNSET POINT set the standard but have both been well found in the market. John Gosden won one of the divisions last year with a debutante and he is represented this year by SPRING FEVER drawn 11 of 12, on My Figures she has to improve around 6lbs but she clearly wasn't ready on debut so is definitely worth an interest. Of the newcomers, only CHOISYA and MISTRAL STAR appeal to me. Neither of the sire's have been prolific with their Two-Year-Old debutantes on the AW but Simon Crisford the more likely to have his ready on debut. For those looking for an each-way alternative, STAR CHILD doesn't have too much to find on My Figures and looks value at around 25/1.
