KEMPTON (A.W) - 6f - BRITISH STALLIONS STUDS EBF FILLIES' RESTRICTED NOVICE STAKES (FOR HORSES IN BANDS C & D) (GBB RACE) (5) 2YO, Class 5

AZURE ANGEL - Rated 81, Rating Rank 2, Speed Rank 4* April Filly out of Silken Skies by Harry Angel * Roger Varian/David Egan, Previous Runs 2, Cost 24,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Third foal, dam 6f winner (RPR 90). Sire high-class Two-Year-Old, including Mill Reef, champion sprinter as Three-Year-Old, including Sprint Cup & July Cup, high-class as a Four-Year-Old. 88 AW Speed Figure. She is a 34.74% strike rate System Qualifier. Confirmed the promise of her 6f Yarmouth debut third to a now 82 rated subsequent winner and a smart looking Gosden winner. 7f looked as far as she needs to go at present as she doesn't lack for speed and looks a bright prospect. The yard have a fantastic 53.33% strike rate with their last time out winning Two-Year-Olds in Novice Company and are 7 from 10 when going off as Favourite.

LUCY LIGHTFOOT (IRE) - Rated 75, Rating Rank 3, Speed Rank 3* February Filly out of Redoutable by Fast Company * Brett Johnson/Paddy Bradley, Previous Runs 7, Cost 20,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Dam a moderate 1 from 14, 0 from 7 as a Two-Year-Old, winning over 6f as a Three-Year-Old, peak rated 99. 92 AW Speed Figure. Having her first run for a yard who can get stable switchers to win on yard debut.

UNHOLY (IRE) - No Rating.* Unraced Filly out of Jollification by Zoffany * George Boughey/Saffie Osborne, Previous Runs 0, Cost 25,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Fifth foal, half-sister to winners Street Parade (5f including as a Two-Year-Old, RPR 103) and Kingboard Star (5f Two-Year-Old, 86), dam 5f Two-Year-Old winner (91). Sire top-class 6-7f Two-Year-Old, including Group 1 Phoenix Stakes, high-class over 9f as a Three-Year-Old, good source of Two-Year-Old's. No AW Speed Figure yet. Looks bred to be a decent speedy Two-Year-Old but the yard are just 4 from 64 with their debutantes so far this year.

RHEA OF THE YEAR - No Rating.* March Filly out of Equimou by Postponed * Robert Eddery/Jason Watson, Previous Runs 2, Cost Unknown. First foal to a moderate dam who was a decent Two-Year-Old winning once over 5f from 6 runs but finished twice in Listed Company again over 5f. No AW Speed Figure yet. Hard to recommend.

BLUE CURACAO - Rated 74, Rating Rank 5, **Speed Rank 1*** April Filly out of Washington Blue by Charm Spirit * Richard Hannon/Sean Levey, Previous Runs 3, Cost Unknown was WD from Yearling Sale. Second foal to a moderate dam who was 1 from 7 as a Two-Year-Old winning on her final start over 9f. Other progeny 0 from 2 as a Two-Year-Old. 97 AW Speed Figure. Hard to recommend and currently Officially Rated just 60.

MINOLI - Rated 64, Rating Rank 6, Speed Rank 6* April Filly out of Anosti by Night Of Thunder * Mike Murphy & Michael Keady/Daniel Muscutt, Previous Runs 2, Cost €20,000 as a Two-Year-Old, 21,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Seventh foal, sister to 9f winner Bliil McGarry (RPR 66), closely related to 9f AW winner Akeed Dubawi (80), half-sister to 5.9f-9f winner Tarnhelm (72), dam 5f Two-Year-Old winner (90). Sire 6f Listed winner as a Two-Year-Old, top miler as a Three and Four-Year-Old, won 2,000 Guineas & Lockinge. 84 AW Speed Figure. Doesn't really catch the eye on breeding and qualified for Handicaps after this.

GALAXY GAZER - Rated 75, Rating Rank 3, Speed Rank 5* April Filly out of Twinkle Twinkle by Iffraaj * James Tate/Rossa Ryan, Previous Runs 5, Cost 23,000 Guineas as a Yearling, 20,000 Guineas as a Foal. Dam a 5 race maiden. 86 AW Speed Figure. Currently Officially Rated just 68 and was comfortably beaten over this trip last time out. Tried in the first-time hood which isn't necessarily a positive from this yard.

INSOLENTE - No Rating.* March Filly out of Fatal Attraction by Harry Angel * Alice Haynes/Kieran O'Neill, Previous Runs 5, Cost 28,000 Guineas as a Yearling, 25,000 Guineas as a Foal. Sixth foal to a 6 race maiden. A half-sister to a couple of Two-Year-Old winners over 6f and Group 3 placed over 7f. No AW Speed Figure yet. Sets the standard on Official Ratings off 73 and she has been consistent on Speed Figures on her last 3 starts. She cost just 6,000 Guineas recently and is making her AW and stable debut in a weak race. The yard don't have the strongest record with their stable switchers in general but are 2 from 6 with Two-Year-Olds from other yards on debut and 2 from 4 on the AW. The Two-Year-Old progeny of Harry Angel are currently operating at 25.53% on the AW (12 from 47).

AMERICAN ROSE - No Rating.* April Filly out of Mortitia by Washington DC * James Evans/Dougie Costello, Previous Runs 1, Cost 15,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Sixth foal, half-sister to winners Northernpowerhouse (6f-7f including Two-Year-Old/AW, RPR 93), Dorcas (6f Two-Year-Old, 68), Ebony Adams (6f Two-Year-Old, 65) and Huddersfilly Town (10f AW 62), dam 6f Two-Year-Old winner (95), out of 6f Listed winner Sire won Windsor Castle S. at two and second in Prix de l'Abbaye as a Three-Year-Old. No AW Speed Figure yet. Won't waste my breath.

TOPO CHICO (IRE) - Rated 85, **Rating Rank 1**, Speed Rank 2* April Filly out of Conversational by Havana Grey * Joseph Parr/Harry Burns, Previous Runs 5, Cost 15,000 Guineas as a Yearling, 15,000 Guineas as a Foal. Fifth foal, half-sister to winners Electric Ladyland (5f including as a Two-Year-Old/AW, RPR 94), Thegreatestshowman (5f-6f including as a Two-Year-Old/AW, 92) and Simmy's Copshop (5f-9f GB Two-Year-Old/Norway, 90), dam 7f/9f AW winner (80). Sire high-class Two-Year-Old, including Molecomb Stakes, won Group 1 Flying Five Stakes as a Three-Year-Old. 94 AW Speed Figure. She did go close over CD back in September finishing just ½L behind a now 79 rated subsequent winner but is beginning to make a habit of finding 1 or 2 too good. She is closely matched with **Blue Curacao** on a collateral form line.

CONCLUSION

It is really hard for me to see past **AZURE ANGEL** but **INSOLENTE** is a very interesting runner making her stable/AW debut and could be a decent alternative.

KEMPTON (A.W) - 7f - BRITISH EBF NOVICE STAKES (SIRE AND DAM RESTRICTED RACE) (GBB RACE) (4) 2YO, Class 4

CEILIDH - No Rating.* January Colt out of Rainbow's Arch by Highland Reel * Hughie Morrison/Hayley Turner, Previous Runs 1, Cost 20,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Third foal to an unraced dam. Full brother to moderate Two-Year-Old winner Reelemine. No AW Speed Figure yet. Hard to recommend.

BRIGHTLY (FR) - No Rating.* Unraced Filly out of Aurora Gold by Sea The Stars * John & Thady Gosden/Kieran O'Neill, Previous Runs 0, Cost €200,000 as a Yearling. Second foal, half-sister to French 8½f AW winner Poliana, dam unraced sister to 10f winner Sun Maiden (including AW/Group 3). Sire Group 2 9f Two-Year-Old, exceptional 6-time Group 1 winner as a Three-Year-Old, including Guineas/Derby/Arc. No AW Speed Figure yet. Looks one for further and possibly later but the yards Two-Year-Old debutantes have been operating at just over 32% since the beginning of October.

SOLUTION - No Rating.* Unraced Gelding out of Luisa Calderon by New Approach * Ralph Beckett/Hector Crouch, Previous Runs 0, Cost 45,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Fourth foal, half-brother to Italian 8½f-10f winner Deron Kit (including as a Two-Year-Old), dam unraced sister to 10f Group 1 winner Lady Marian. Sire five-time Gr1 winner over 7-12f as a Two-Year-Old-3. No AW Speed Figure yet. Another that looks likely to be better in time over further and the yard's Two-Year-Olds have generally been needing a run and are just 5 from 55 since the beginning of October.

CLARKO'S BACK - Rated 78, Rating Rank 3, **Speed Rank 1*** March Colt out of Dubai Bounty by Harry Angel * Jamie Osborne/Thomas Greatrex, Previous Runs 2, Cost 70,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Seventh foal, half-brother to winners Kachy (5f-6f including as a Two-Year-Old Group 3/AW, rated 119), Gifted Ruler (6f Two-Year-Old/9f, rated 97), Bakersboy 10f AW, rated 90) and Maximum Effect (11f AW rated 87), dam 8.6f-12f winner (including as a Two-Year-Old/AW rated 87) 98 AW Speed Figure. Bred to be speedy but the day I recommend a Two-Year-Old from this disgusting yard will be the day I give up betting.

SAVVY BRILLIANCE - Rated 79, Rating Rank 2, Speed Rank 3* March Colt out of Pongee by Cracksman * S Woods/Daniel Muscutt, Previous Runs 1, Cost 180,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Eleventh foal, half-brother to 8 winners including Drill (9f-12f including AW/Australia Listed, RPR 112), Pinzolo (9f-14f including Two-Year-Old/AW/Listed, 110), Poplin (9f Two-Year-Old, 103) and Materialistic (7f Two-Year-Old/9f, 101), dam 10f-12f winner (including Group 2, 109). Sire 9f winner as Two-Year-Old, champion Three-Year-Old colt & four time Group 1 winner as a Three to Four-Year-Old, including dual Champion Stakes 90 AW Speed Figure. He made perfectly satisfactory debut considering that he is bred to come into his own over middle distances next year.

JAMES BRADLEY - No Rating.* Unraced Gelding out of Nadia Glory by Sea The Stars * Charlie Wallis/Joshua Bryan, Previous Runs 0, Cost 50,000 Guineas as a Yearling, 170,000 Guineas as a Foal. Second foal, dam unraced. Sire Group 2 9f Two-Year-Old, exceptional 6-time Group 1 winner as a Three-Year-Old, including Guineas/Derby/Arc. No AW Speed Figure yet. The yard are 0 from 42 with all of their Two-Year-Olds.

SCARLET - No Rating.* January Filly out of Symbol by Sir Percy * Tony Newcombe/William Cox, Previous Runs 1, Cost Unknown. Second foal, dam placed 12f on the AW (RPR 78). Sire won the Dewhurst and Derby, second in 2,000 Guineas, does produce Two-Year-Olds, but progeny generally

progress. No AW Speed Figure yet. The yard have only ever had 2 winning Two-Year-Olds from 107 runners with the last 1 in 2007 and are 0 from 55 since.

DRAGON ICON (IRE) - No Rating.* Unraced Colt out of Matauri Pearl by Lope De Vega * Roger Varian/David Egan, Previous Runs 0, Cost 360,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Fourth foal, brother to US 9f-8½f turf Two-Year-Old winner Aunt Pearl (including Grade 1 BC Juvenile Fillies Turf, RPR 115), half-brother to 2 winners including Fall In Love (French 9f Two-Year-Old winner, 108), dam Swedish 9f winner (including as a Two-Year-Old/Champion Three-Year-Old filly in Scandinavia, 97. Sire high-class Two-Year-Old, French 2,000 Guineas/Derby winner, well related, quality sire. No AW Speed Figure yet. The most expensive in the field but the yard's Two-Year-Olds generally improve for the run.

SEA OF THIEVES - No Rating.* Unraced Filly out of Grande Bleue by Cracksman * Ed Walker/Saffie Osborne, Previous Runs 0, Cost Unknown. Second foal, dam 7f winner (RPR 76), closely related to smart sprinter Arcibo. Sire 9f winner as Two-Year-Old, champion Three-Year-Old colt & four time Group 1 winner as a Three to Four-Year-Old, including dual Champion Stakes. No AW Speed Figure yet. So far this year the yard are just 1 from 31 with their Two-Year-Old debutantes and the sire's Two-Year-Old progeny are just 2 from 36 on debut.

BALANCE PLAY (IRE) - No Rating.* May Gelding out of Bezique by Lope De Vega * Ralph Beckett/Rossa Ryan, Previous Runs 1, Cost 280,000 Guineas as a Yearling, 260,000 Guineas as a Foal. Fifth foal, half-brother to winners Khalidi (9f-11f including Two-Year-Old/Listed, RPR 114), House Edge (9f Two-Year-Old, 92) and Assembled (9f including AW, 78), dam Italian 7½f-9f winner (including Two-Year-Old/Listed, 101). Sire high-class Two-Year-Old, French 2,000 Guineas/Derby winner, well related, quality sire. No AW Speed Figure yet. Made a promising debut at Nottingham making headway from midfield on soft ground before fading inside the final furlong. He can be expected to progress, but the market will be a strong guide as all 6 of the yards second-start winners this year have gone off at 3/1 or less.

NAILS MURPHY (IRE) - Rated 94, **Rating Rank 1, Speed Rank 1*** April Colt out of Supernovae by Sioux Nation * Richard Hughes/Adam Kirby, Previous Runs 1, Cost Unknown. Eighth foal, closely related to Italian 6f/9f winner Sopran Marte, half-brother to three winners including Solene Lilyette (9f-10f including Listed, RPR 102) and Scorpion Black (7f/9f, 70), dam 12f AW winner (76) out of 9f GB Group 2/US 9f Grade 1 winner. Sire High-class Two-Year-Old, including Norfolk & Phoenix Stakes, won Group 3 Lacken Stakes as a Three-Year-Old. 98 AW Speed Figure. Is comfortably clear on My Performance and Speed Figures. This son of Sioux Nation benefited from making his move just fractionally ahead of the favourite on his debut over this trip at Chelmsford and wasn't for catching thereafter, he should stay further, and the yard are 2 from 4 so far this year with their second-start Two-Year-Olds that won on debut and the first-season sire's Two-Year-Olds have made a good start.

ELNAJMM - No Rating.* Unraced Colt out of Muneyra by Sea The Stars * William Haggas/Adam Farragher, Previous Runs 0, Cost Unknown. First foal, dam 7f AW winner (RPR 78), sister to winners Luck Or Design (6f-9f including Ire Two-Year-Old/HK/Singapore Group 1 as Lucky Nine) and Dayking (7f), half-sister to Japanese 6f Grade 3 winner Teehaff out of 6f-7f winner. Sire Group 2 9f Two-Year-Old, exceptional 6-time Group 1 winner as a Three-Year-Old, including Guineas/Derby/Arc No AW Speed Figure yet. His dam won over this trip at Wolverhampton as a Two-Year-Old for this yard, who aren't really associated with their Two-Year-Olds winning on debut (3 from 43 so far in 2022).

STAGE SHOW - No Rating.* January Gelding out of Floria Tosca by Showcasing * Harry & Roger Charlton/Richard Kingscote, Previous Runs 2, Cost 110,000 Guineas as a Yearling. First foal to a dam who was unraced as a Two-Year-Old, winning twice from 9 starts as a Three-Year-Old over 11½f and

12f. No AW Speed Figure yet. Did step up on her debut without being really tried with. He looks one for handicaps further down the line over further.

GRAHAM - No Rating.* May Colt out of Gravitation by Time Test * Richard Hannon/Sean Levey, Previous Runs 1, Cost Unknown. Tenth foal, half-brother to 7 winners including Gibeon who won over 7f on debut as a Two-Year-Old/10f, RPR 108), Gemina who also won over 7f on her Two-Year-Old debut, 89), Girling (11.6f, 89) and Grinling (10f/11.4f 87), dam 12f and 14f (Group 3) winner (108). Sire Dual Group 2 winner 9f-10f, out of Two-Year-Old Group 1 winner over 10f Passage Of Time. No AW Speed Figure yet. Looks bred for this trip and to be a winning Two-Year-Old but does need to improve on his debut run and the yard are 0 from 19 so far this year with their second-start Two-Year-Olds switching to the AW.

CONCLUSION

NAILS MURPHY sets a clear standard for the rest to aim at but there are a number of interesting newcomers with the most likely being **BRIGHTLY**.
