Great State - Rated 81, Rating Rank 3, **Speed Rank 1*** January Gelding out of Foxcatcher by Havana Grey * Richard Fahey/Oisin Orr, Previous Runs 1, Cost 60,000 Guineas as a Yearling, 14,000 Guineas as a Foal. Second foal, dam 5f Two-Year-Old winner (RPR 73). Sire high-class Two-Year-Old, including Molecomb Stakes, won Group 1 Flying Five Stakes as a Three-Year-Old, from speedy family. 98 AW Speed Figure. Possibly came up against a decent one on debut when finishing third over CD, with the second, third and fourth finishing bunched up just over 4½L behind Pure Angel. The standard was being set by the fourth with an Official Rating of 86. The yard are 11 from 48 with their second-start Two-Year-Olds so far in 2022. Interesting but slight doubt about the surface.

Crimson Angel - No Rating.* Unraced Filly out of Fanrouge by Harry Angel * Clive Cox/John Fahy, Previous Runs 0, Cost Unknown. Fifth foal, closely related to winners Prince Of The Dark (5.7f Two-Year-Old, RPR 102) & Shimla Rolaan (7f AW/9f turf, 69), dam 5f-6f winner (including as a Two-Year-Old, 92). Sire high-class Two-Year-Old, including Mill Reef, champion sprinter as Three-Year-Old, including Sprint Cup & July Cup, high-class as a Four-Year-Old. No AW Speed Figure yet. The progeny of Harry Angel have only had 3 winning Two-Year-Old debutantes and are 0 from 14 over 5f on debut but overall the Two-Year-Old progeny have only had 8 qualifiers over CD with 2 winners and a further 4 placed. Interesting in a weak race especially if the market speaks significantly.

Stocks Park - Rated 75, Rating Rank 4, Speed Rank 5* April Filly out of Lever Park by Mayson * Robyn Brisland/William Carson, Previous Runs 1, Cost Unknown. Second foal, dam unraced. Sire smart 5-6f Two-Year-Old, later top-class sprinter, including July Cup winner & Abbaye runner-up, speed source. 92 AW Speed Figure. Of all of the surfaces, the Two-Year-Old progeny of Mayson have the better strike rate on Tapeta, generally operating at just over 18% at both Newcastle and Wolverhampton, they are 4 from 13 if their second start is on Tapeta.

So Many Questions - Rated 82, Rating Rank 2, **Speed Rank 1*** February Colt out of Fig Roll by Showcasing * Harry & Roger Charlton/Thomas Greatrex, Previous Runs 1, Cost , 85,000 Guineas as a Yearling was WD from Two-Year-Old. Fourth foal, closely related to 5f winner Mystify Me (RPR 70), half-brother to winners Al Raya (5f including Group 3, 105) & Grisons (5f-6f including AW, 79), dam 5f

and 6f (Listed) Two-Year-Old winner (99). Sire high-class sprint Two-Year-Old, runner-up in Duke Of York Stakes as a Three-Year-Old. 98 AW Speed Figure. Finished just a head in front of Great State over CD on debut but the yard are another with a poor second-start record.

Huckleberry - No Rating.* Unraced Gelding out of Enchanted Princess by Unfortunately * Charlie Wallis/David Nolan, Previous Runs 0, Cost 1,500 Guineas as a Yearling. Thirteenth foal, half-brother to 8 winners up to 7f including Morache Music (6f-7f including as a Two-Year-Old, RPR 111), Vintage Clarets (5f including as a Two-Year-Old, 99), Never Lose (6f/7f, 93) and Enchanted Linda (5f including as a Two-Year-Old, 83), dam 9f winner (80), out of 7f Two-Year-Old winner. Sire Champion Two-Year-Old in France, won Prix Morny, won 6f Gr3 Renaissance Stakes as a Three-Year-Old. No AW Speed Figure yet. The yard are 0 from 41 with their Two-Year-Olds.

Soaring Eagle (IRE) - Rated 84, **Rating Rank 1**, Speed Rank 3* March Filly out of Heartlines by Gleneagles * Simon & Ed Crisford/Harry Burns, Previous Runs 2, Cost Unknown. Second foal to a dam unraced as a Two-Year-Old and 1 from 3 as a Three-Year-Old, winning over 7f on her final start. Other progeny currently 0 from 22, well beaten in 5 starts as a Two-Year-Old over 7f to 10f and currently rated just 48. 97 AW Speed Figure. Cost 210,000€ at a breeze-up sale, she was returning from a 111 day absence last time out when she was well positioned up front alongside the winner, but she didn't settle as well as her, and was outpaced when she quickened up, finishing just over 1½L fourth with a 90 rated runner in second over 6f at Chelmsford. Her sire's Two-Year-Old progeny don't have a great record on Tapeta with just 4 wins from 44 starts but 3 of those wins (from 18) were here. Interesting with that run under her belt.

Muckleton - No Rating.* Unraced Filly out of Wakened by Twilight Son * Richard Fahey/Connor Murtagh, Previous Runs 0, Cost Unknown was WD from Yearling Sale. Second foal, half-sister to 7f winner Maywake (including AW, RPR 90), dam placed over 7f AW as a Two-Year-Old (55). Sire 6f winner as a Two-Year-Old, won Haydock Sprint Cup/Diamond Jubilee as a Three-Year-Old-4. No AW Speed Figure yet. A second runner for Richard Fahey but rather worryingly the yard have had just 4 second-start Two-Year-Old winners from 60 qualifiers so far in 2022.

Mr Rascal - Rated 56, Rating Rank 7, Speed Rank 8* March Gelding out of A Huge Dream by Showcasing * George Boughey/Adam Farragher, Previous Runs 2, Cost 28,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Sixth foal, closely related to 5f-5½f winner Mrs Gallagher (including Two-Year-Old/Listed, RPR 104), half-brother to winners Tone The Barone (5f-6f including AW, 111) and Chasing Dreams (5f-6f including Two-Year-Old/AW, 95), dam Listed-placed 6f winner (99) Sire high-class sprint Two-Year-Old, runner up in the Duke Of York Stakes as a Three-Year-Old. 83 AW Speed Figure. He was well backed last time out when making his AW debut, but he carried his head a bit high in the straight and could make no impression over 6f at Kempton. Market will be indicative of his chances.

Northern Spirit - Rated 67, Rating Rank 5, Speed Rank 3* April Gelding out of Amelia Grace by Aday * Brian Ellison/Dale Swift, Previous Runs 2, Cost Unknown. Second foal to an unraced dam but other progeny 0 from 9. 97 AW Speed Figure. Hard to recommend considering he will be qualified for Handicaps after this.

Dream Mission - Rated 56, Rating Rank 7, Speed Rank 6* April Colt out of Luna Mission by Oasis Dream * Archie Watson/Sydney Cale, Previous Runs 2, Cost Unknown. Fourth foal, closely related to 5f Two-Year-Old winner Sagittarius (RPR 77), dam 6f AW Two-Year-Old winner (74). Sire top-class Two-Year-Old/sprinter, won July Cup, gets high-class sprinters to middle-distance runners and Two-Year-Olds. 87 AW Speed Figure. Hard to recommend considering he will be qualified for Handicaps after this.

CONCLUSION

Hard to be confident here with **Great State**, **So Many Questions** and **Soaring Eagle** so closely matched. The newcomers don't come with many stats in their favour, but it is a weak race so any confidence behind **Crimson Angel** should be noted.

Quiet Smile - No Rating.* Unraced Filly out of Glee Club by War Command * Ian Williams/Ben Sanderson, Previous Runs 0, Cost Unknown. Fifth foal, half-sister to the moderate 5f/5.7f Two-Year-Old winner Suanni, including on the AW, RPR 83, dam placed 8.7f in Germany, sister to Group-placed 5f Two-Year-Old winner Tawaabb, useful 5f-6f winner Kylaene and 6f-15f Flat/useful 2m hurdle winner Golden Spear. Sire high-class juvenile, won Coventry, Futurity and Dewhurst Stakes. No AW Speed Figure yet. The yard have only had 1 Two-Year-Old win on debut from 63 runners. Not for me.

Way To Amarillo (FR) - Rated 86, **Rating Rank 1**, Speed Rank 3* April Filly out of Peinted Song by Shalaa * Archie Watson/Taylor Fisher, Previous Runs 2, Cost €140,000 as a Yearling. Fifth foal to a dam unraced as a Two-Year-Old and 1 from 10 overall winning over 7½f. Related to a Two-Year-Old winner over 7f. 91 AW Speed Figure. Hasn't run for 150 days since finishing a well backed neck second at Kempton over this trip when trying to make all. Form looks weak with just 1 winner from 32 subsequent runs.

Warren Hill (IRE) - No Rating.* March Filly out of Travel by No Nay Never * Roger Varian/Cameron Noble, Previous Runs 1, Cost 100,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Fourth foal, half-sister to winners Global Storm (Group-placed 9f-14f including as a Two-Year-Old, RPR 111) and El Pepino (Sweden 9f), dam 14f-16f AW winner (83). Sire Unbeaten Two-Year-Old, including Norfolk & Morny, won 5f Grade 3 and runner-up in Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint as a Three-Year-Old. No AW Speed Figure yet. She was well fancied on debut at Newmarket last month on soft ground when up with the pace for most of the way before possibly getting tired in the ground, there should be better to come, so of interest.

Starproof (IRE) - No Rating.* Unraced Filly out of Dufoof by Camacho * William Muir & Chris Grassick/Oliver Stammers, Previous Runs 0, Cost 35,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Third foal, half-sister to winners Master Zoffany (7f-9f including as a Two-Year-Old, RPR 92) & Quercus (6f, 63), dam placed 7f (58). Sire useful Three-Year-Old sprinter, from good family, good source of Two-Year-Old winners. No AW Speed Figure yet. Hard to recommend.

Twinkle Star - No Rating.* Unraced Filly out of Cloud's End by Oasis Dream * Paul & Oliver Cole/Joshua Bryan, Previous Runs 0, Cost 95,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Sixth foal, half-sister to 5f winner Ishvara who won on her racecourse debut as a Two-Year-Old, RPR 96) and 5f-6f winner Zamjar, including as a Two-Year-Old over 6f and later won 4 times on the AW, at Newcastle, Lingfield and Chelmsford over 5f and 6f, dam 6f AW Two-Year-Old winner and a 7f turf winner (82). Sire top-class Two-Year-Old/sprinter, won July Cup, gets high-class sprinters to middle-distance runners and Two-Year-Olds. No AW Speed Figure yet. Distance may stretch her on debut but bred to be a decent Two-Year-Old. Very interesting runner for owners who know what they have, market will be indicative of her chances.

Lakota Lass (IRE) - No Rating.* Unraced Filly out of Iffraaj Pink by Sioux Nation * Charles Hills/William Carson, Previous Runs 0, Cost Unknown. Fourth foal, half-sister to 12f AW winner You're So Vain (RPR 74), dam 9f winner with plenty of AW Breeding. Sire High-class Two-Year-Old, including Norfolk & Phoenix Stakes, won Group 3 Lacken Stakes as a Three-Year-Old, speedy family. No AW Speed Figure yet. Has a decent pedigree but possibly one for further down the line over longer distances.

Marmara Star - Rated 60, Rating Rank 7, Speed Rank 7* March Filly out of Lunearia by Golden Horn * George Boughey/Harry Burns, Previous Runs 1, Cost 30,000 Guineas as a Foal. Second foal, dam unraced sister to Group-placed GB/HK 9f-10f winner (including AW Two-Year-Old) Impulsive Moment and Listed-placed 12f-14f winner Inchicore. Sire 9f Two-Year-Old winner, champion Three-Year-Old & horse of the year, won Derby, Eclipse, Irish Champion Stakes & Arc. 80 AW Speed Figure. Interesting on paper but another that looks likely to be better in time over further and market indicative of chances.

Statu Of Liberty - Rated 83, Rating Rank 2, **Speed Rank 1*** April Filly out of Mania by Washington DC * Brian Meehan/Jonny Peate, Previous Runs 5, Cost 42,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Thirteenth foal to an unraced dam. Related to several decent Two-Year-Old winners over 6f and 7f. 7 Of the 10 progeny to have run as a Two-Year-Old won giving a WTR of 43% 94 AW Speed Figure. Has to give 6lbs to all of her rivals but has to be of interesting considering her Speed Figures have been consistently better than most in the field.

Ceanna - Rated 75, Rating Rank 4, Speed Rank 3* March Filly out of Penelopa by Showcasing * John & Thady Gosden/Collen Storey, Previous Runs 1, Cost 140,000 Guineas as a Two-Year-Old, 80,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Cost 140,000gns as Two-Year-Old, fifth foal, closely related to winners Disco Fever (7f AW Two-Year-Old, RPR 85) and Paggane (Fr 13f), half-sister to 12f/13f (Listed) AW winner Pennymoor (99), dam 6f Two-Year-Old/11f (German Oaks) winner (102) out of US GSP 9f-9f winner. Sire high-class sprint Two-Year-Old, second in Duke Of York S. as a Three-Year-Old, 1/2 to Camacho, excellent source of Two-Year-Olds. 91 AW Speed Figure. Was over 2L behind **Embrace** on debut but didn't live up to market expectations, being slowly away and towards the back throughout. She should be clearly better than that being closely related to the stables Disco Fever who won over 7f on the AW at Lingfield as a Two-Year-Old on her second start.

Impulsive Lady (IRE) - Rated 75, Rating Rank 4, Speed Rank 5* March Filly out of Impala by Frankel * James Tate/Adam Farragher, Previous Runs 1, Cost Unknown. Second foal, dam unraced. Sire Highest-ever rated racehorse by RPRs, unbeaten 10-time Group 1 winner. 88 AW Speed Figure. Should improve greatly for her debut run with the Two-Year-Old progeny of Frankel showing a 38.89% strike rate on their second start compared to just 1 from 32 on debut. She was comfortably beaten in to third on debut over this trip at Kempton but was trying to make all against two well fancied runners from the Charlie Appleby and John Gosden yards. Interesting for a yard who have sent 5 Two-Year-Olds here so far this year, resulting in 2 winners and 2 further placed. All were well found in the market going off at 4/1 and below.

Embrace (IRE) - Rated 81, Rating Rank 3, Speed Rank 1* January Filly out of Whazzis by Lope De Vega * Owen Burrows/Oisin Orr, Previous Runs 1, Cost 70,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Eleventh foal, closely related to 7f AW winner Kahala Queen RPR 63), dam 7f-9f winner (including AW Two-Year-Old/Italy Group 3, 107). Sire high-class Two-Year-Old before becoming the French 2,000 Guineas/Derby winner. 94 AW Speed Figure. Went straight in to My Tracker with notes “blatantly kept out of the places under tender handling on debut”, she was running on well from the back of the field at Kempton over this trip and she didn't have a hard race. Has to be of interest has she clearly has improvement in her, whether connections are ready to let her show it is another story.

River Lyne - Rated 64, Rating Rank 6, Speed Rank 5* February Filly out of Piranha by Massaat * Stuart Williams/Dylan Hogan, Previous Runs 2, Cost 40,000 Guineas as a Yearling, 10,000 Guineas as a Foal. Seventh foal, half-sister to winners Go On Go On Go On (5f-6f including AW Two-Year-Old, 100), Dahawi (GB/UAE 5f-6f including AW/dirt, 97) and Ronnie The Rooster (7f/9f AW, 71), dam 5f AW Two-Year-Old winner (80). Sire Classy over 7f-9f, second in Dewhurst and 2,000 Guineas, won Hungerford as a Four-Year-Old. 88 AW Speed Figure. Possibly one for Handicaps but owners have had big priced winning Two-Year-Olds.

CONCLUSION

Way To Amarillo and **Statu Of Liberty** set the standard albeit not too high and personally I would be a little disappointed if there wasn't something better in the field. **Embrace** is clearly better than she was allowed to show on debut but has been well found so I will be splitting my stake proportionally on **Impulsive Lady** and **Ceanna**.

Chamber Choir - No Rating.* April Filly out of Polymnia by Ardad * Oliver Greenall & Josh Guerriero/Ryan Sexton, Previous Runs 2, Cost 37,000 Guineas as a Yearling. First foal to a poor dam who was just 1 from 25 and well beaten in 4 starts as a Two-Year-Old. No AW Speed Figure yet.

Roarin' Success - Rated 77, Rating Rank 4, **Speed Rank 1*** March Filly out of Random Success by Roaring Lion * Harry & Roger Charlton/Thomas Greatrex, Previous Runs 2, Cost Unknown. Third foal, dam was a moderate 5f-6f winner (including AW, RPR 89). Sire Son of Kitten's Joy, 4 times Group 1 winner, placed in Racing Post Trophy & Derby. 101 AW Speed Figure.

Eastern Charm (IRE) - Rated 49, Rating Rank 6, Speed Rank 6* January Filly out of Chastushka by Kodiak * William Haggas/Oisin Orr, Previous Runs 2, Cost 28,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Cost €74,377 as a Two-Year-Old, second foal, closely related to 9f AW Two-Year-Old/10f turf winner Livia The Empress (RPR 72), dam 9f Two-Year-Old winner (97) out of 7f Two-Year-Old Group 3/9f AW Listed winner. Sire was useful over 6f to 7f and a leading source of speed. 77 AW Speed Figure.

Immersion (FR) - Rated 28, Rating Rank 7, Speed Rank 6* March Filly out of First Chope by Born To Sea * George Boughey/Jonny Peate, Previous Runs 1, Cost Unknown. Seventh foal, half-sister to winners Cosachope (4.7f-5f Two-Year-Old including Group 3, RPR 101) and Foreverchop (2m2f hurdle), dam unplaced 7f/9f. Sire Two-Year-Old 6f Listed winner & second in Irish Derby. 77 AW Speed Figure.

Coral Reef (IRE) - No Rating.* February Filly out of Mehronissa by Invincible Spirit * Archie Watson/Taylor Fisher, Previous Runs 1, Cost 120,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Second foal to a Listed Race winning dam over 6f who won over 7f on her only start as a Two-Year-Old. No AW Speed Figure yet.

Rajindri (IRE) - Rated 88, **Rating Rank 1**, Speed Rank 3* May Filly out of Ugneya by Profitable * Tom Clover/Harry Burns, Previous Runs 1, Cost 50,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Second foal, dam unraced. Sire progressed into top-class sprinter, won King's Stand Stakes as a Four-Year-Old, runner-up as a Five-Year-Old. 97 AW Speed Figure.

Out Of Mischief - Rated 58, Rating Rank 5, Speed Rank 5* March Filly out of More Mischief by Invincible Spirit * Jedd O'Keefe/James Sullivan, Previous Runs 1, Cost Unknown. Second foal, dam 9f-12f winner (including Listed, RPR 105). Sire won Haydock Sprint Cup, dam won French Oaks. 82 AW Speed Figure.

La Traviata (IRE) - Rated 18, Rating Rank 8, Speed Rank 8* March Filly out of Carpe Vita by Kingman * Rebecca Menzies/Cameron Noble, Previous Runs 1, Cost Unknown. Third foal, dam 14f winner (RPR 78), sister to Leger/Gold Cup winner Leading Light, 13f Flat/smart 2m hurdle winner John Constable and Group-placed 10f winner Warwick Avenue. Sire Top-class Two-Year-Old, including Solario Stakes, four time Group 1 winner, Champion Three-Year-Old. 65 AW Speed Figure.

Taswara - No Rating.* Unraced Filly out of Timarwa by Tasleet * Clive Cox/John Fahy, Previous Runs 0, Cost 18,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Eighth foal, half-sister to 5 winners including Tinandali (Ire/Australia 9f-10f, RPR 106), Timiyan (12f Flat, 103/useful 2m-3m1f hurdle/chase) & Tregony who was 4 from 6 on the AW at Lingfield and Newcastle, all over 10f, dam finished a close second over 8f on her only start as a Two-Year-Old but won twice as a Three-Year-Old including over 9.4f in Group 3 Company, out of 9½f-10f Group 1 winner. Sire From family of Battaash, stakes winner as a Two-Year-Old, 3 and 4, won Group 2 Duke of York Stakes. Likely one for next year. No AW Speed Figure yet.

Glittering Lights - Rated 87, Rating Rank 2, Speed Rank 2* March Filly out of Show Day by Kingman * Charlie Appleby/Adam Farragher, Previous Runs 2, Cost Unknown. Third foal, half-sister to winners Marching Army (10f-11f including AW, RPR 107) and Show Lights (10f AW, 76), dam 9f-9f winner (including German Listed, 100), sister to 9f/9f Group 2 winner Usherette. Sire was a top-class Two-Year-Old, including Solario Stakes, four time Group 1 winner, Champion Three-Year-Old. 98 AW Speed Figure.

Tallulah Myla (IRE) - Rated 78, Rating Rank 3, Speed Rank 4* April Filly out of Sheikhakan by Oasis Dream * Stuart Williams/Dylan Hogan, Previous Runs 2, Cost 65,000 Guineas as a Two-Year-Old, 27,000 Guineas as a Yearling. First foal, dam French 10½f winner, sister to useful 7f-9f winner Mujazif. Sire top-class Two-Year-Old/sprinter, won July Cup, gets high-class sprinters to middle-distance runners and Two-Year-Olds. 93 AW Speed Figure.

CONCLUSION

I don't intend to go into too much depth here as the majority of the field look projects for next year and the one, I like on the figures, **Chamber Choir** is questionable as to whether she will be run on merit now making her debut for Oliver Greenall after leaving the Gosden yard for just £8,000 since her second at Yarmouth in the first-time cheekpieces. Her dam won over 8f, so this slightly stiffer test should be ideal, and she sets the standard on this switch to AW. A decent run by either Embrace or Ceanna in the previous race will boost the form of **Rajindri** as she finished 2½L and 4½L in front of them restively. **Glittering Lights** has disappointed at short prices on both of her starts so far so at likely short odds again I will be happy to watch her win.
