Relevant Stats/Trends : Those Two-Year-Old runners making their racecourse debut in AW Maiden Company operate at just over 7%

MY KIND OF GIRL (FR) - Rated 53, AW Rating Rank 4, AW Speed Rating Rank 6* April Filly out of Etrangere by Hunter's Light * Tony Carroll/Mollie Phillips, Previous Runs 1, Cost Unknown. Eighth foal, half-sister to winners French Pegasus (6f-9f including on the AW, RPR 96), Essai Transforme (6½f AW/7f turf, 87) & You Are My World (6f on the AW, 60), dam unplaced 5½f/9f in France. Sire top-class 9-11f performer at Three to Seven-Year-Old, was placed over 7f as a Two-Year-Old. **79 AW Speed Figure.** Related to a couple of AW winners but other progeny were 0 from 7 as Two-Year-Olds. Yard don't have a strong record in Two-Year-Old AW Maidens. <u>Advice: Likely one for next year once in Handicaps.</u>

TWO DESSERTS (IRE) - No Rating.* Unraced Colt out of Nasimi by Kodiac * Alice Haynes/Kieran O'Neill, Previous Runs 0, Cost Unknown. Second foal, half-brother to 6f turf Two-Year-Old/7f AW winner Little Prayer (RPR 82), dam 6f Two-Year-Old winner (86). Sire useful 6-7f, dam won French Oaks. **No AW Speed Figure yet**. Looks a likely type on paper and this yard have shown a very profitable 27% strike rate in Two-Year-Old Maiden Company so far this year. <u>Advice: One for the shortlist.</u>

JAHIDIN (FR) - No Rating.* Unraced Gelding out of Loda by Kheleyf * K R Burke/Sam James, Previous Runs 0, Cost Unknown. Sixth living foal, half-brother to 3 winners including Ruby Wedding (French 5½f-6½f) and Tahanrun (French 2m1f-2m7f hurdle/chase), dam French 5f-7½f winner (including as Two-Year-Old/Listed, RPR 100). Sire winner of Group 3 Jersey Stakes, good source of Two-Year-Old winner. No AW Speed Figure yet. Already gelded and was withdrawn from a Novice Stakes on Friday when playing up at the stalls, unseating the rider and running loose. The yard's Two-Year-Old debutantes have shown a decent 22.86% strike rate in Two-Year-Old Maiden Company so far this year. Advice: The yard's Two-Year-Old winners are generally well found and due to unruly behaviour last time worth watching in the market and the start.

HELLO HAVANA (IRE) - Rated 54, AW Rating Rank 4, AW Speed Rating Rank 3* February Filly out of Hello Brigette by Galileo Gold * Iain Jardine/Andrew Mullen, Previous Runs 7, Cost €12,000 as a Two-Year-Old. First foal to a moderate dam who was 1 from 3 as a Two-Year-Old winning over 6f and later 1 from 9 as a Three-Year-Old again over 6f. **80.21 AW Speed Figure**. Hard to make a case for having weakened inside the final furlong on 5 of her 7 starts to date. <u>Advice: Leave</u>

SMART SHOT - No Rating.* Unraced Colt out of Sinaadi by Outstrip * Tony Carroll/Jason Watson, Previous Runs 0, Cost Unknown. Fifth foal, dam 10f winner (RPR 89). Sire was a Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf winner over 9f. **No AW Speed Figure yet**. This one looks bred for further and the yard don't have a strong record in Two-Year-Old AW Maidens but an interesting Jockey booking. <u>Advice: Likely one</u> <u>for next year once in Handicaps over further.</u>

ONCE ADAAY - No Rating.* March Colt out of Sonko by Adaay * Mrs Ilka Gansera-Leveque/George Wood, Previous Runs 2, Cost 15,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Fifth foal, brother to 5f winners including the 70 rated Four Adaay who was 2 from 5 on the AW, winning twice at Lingfield, RPR 82 and the poor 48 rated Miss Anaco who was 1 from 9 on the AW, winning at Lingfield over 5f, 62), dam was a 5f winner including as a Two-Year-Old on the AW on Fibresand and Polytrack, RPR 88. Sire 240,000gns Two-Year-Old, 6f winner as a Two-Year-Old, dual 6-7f Group 2 winner as a Three-Year-Old. No AW

Speed Figure yet. Hard to make a case on his two previous runs on turf, running to a Performance Figure of just 54 and this track/surface noy guaranteed to suit on pedigree. <u>Advice: Leave</u>

TURBO TIGER (IRE) - Rated 64, **AW Rating Rank 1**, **AW Speed Rating Rank 1*** May Colt out of Wardat Dubai by Markaz * Antony Brittain/Mark Winn, Previous Runs 3, Cost Unknown was WD from Yearling Sale. Fourth foal to a twice winning dam over 8½f at Beverley and Wolverhampton but 0 from 2 as a Two-Year-Old. A full-brother to Snash who was 1 from 3 as a Two-Year-Old last year, winning at Wolverhampton over 6f on his Second start. **81 AW Speed Figure**. Sets a clear standard with an Official Rating of 72 which may be a little flattering on recent efforts. He did run ok here over 5f on debut in a race that has produced 6 subsequent wins including the seventh placed runner who was 4L behind him winning 3 times since and now rated 79. Does set the standard albeit not too high of a one and the yard's Two-Year-Olds are 0 from 64 in non-handicaps. <u>Advice: Each-Way chance at the very least.</u>

BURENA (IRE) - Rated 61, AW Rating Rank 2, AW Speed Rating Rank 2* April Filly out of Xena by Buratino * Clive Cox/John Fahy, Previous Runs 2, Cost Unknown. Eighth foal, half-sister to 5 winners including New Planet 5f-6f including Two-Year-Old Listed, RPR 105), Majestic Hero (5f including as a Two-Year-Old, 96), Areina (6f Two-Year-Old, 83) and Planetex (5f-6f, 79). dam unraced. Sire tough and classy Two-Year-Old, including Coventry Stakes, unplaced as a Three-Year-Old. **79.54 AW Speed Figure**. Related to a couple of moderate Two-Year-Old winners. Was behind a couple of subsequent winners on debut and showed an improved effort last time out at Kempton behind Friday's Newcastle runner up, Macho Mania. The yard's Two-Year-Olds are 2 from 32 in Maiden Company so far this year. **Advice: Interesting runner in a weak race but likely one for Handicaps.**

MR GLOVERMAN - Rated 64, AW Rating Rank 4, AW Speed Rating Rank 3* March Gelding out of Xylophone by Lethal Force * Kevin Frost/David Nolan, Previous Runs 1, Cost 4,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Second foal, dam unplaced 9f-12f (RPR 57). Sire Coventry fourth as a Two-Year-Old, 7f Group 2 winner as a Three-Year-Old, won Diamond Jubilee & July Cup as a Four-Year-Old. **79.54 AW Speed Figure**. The yard have only had 7 Two-Year-Old runners so far in 2022 (3 different horses, 1 winner) with 2 wins. Was soon beaten on debut over this trip at Newcastle. <u>Advice: Worth a market check but percentage call to leave</u>.

SUMAC (IRE) - Rated 50, AW Rating Rank 5, AW Speed Rating Rank 5* February Gelding out of Spring Eternal by Belardo * Charlie Wallis/William Carson, Previous Runs 1, Cost 11,000 Guineas as a Two-Year-Old, 10,000 Guineas as a Yearling. First foal, dam Italian 5f winner, sister to 7f AW winner Plover. Sire top-class Two-Year-Old, including Dewhurst, won Lockinge as a Four-Year-Old. **79.21 AW Speed Figure.** The yard have never had a Two-Year-Old winner. <u>Advice: Leave</u>

MARYCULTER - No Rating AW Speed Rating Rank 7* April Filly out of Money Note by Profitable * Suzzanne France/Faye McManoman, Previous Runs 2, Cost 1,500 Guineas as a Yearling. Seventh foal to a 7 race maiden who was unraced as a Two-Year-Old. 5 of her other progeny have run as Two-Year-Olds with only 1 winner and a record of 1 from 26 over 5f to 9f. **64 AW Speed Figure**. Beaten just 2 rivals home from a possible 17 and beaten a combined distance of over 46L in both starts so far. **Advice: Leave.**

REMUNERATOR (IRE) - No Rating.* Unraced Filly out of Roxelana by Profitable * George Boughey/Kevin Stott, Previous Runs 0, Cost 12,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Fifth foal, half-sister to 5f Two-Year-Old winner Lynn's Memory (RPR 72), dam 9f AW winner (82), closely related to 9f Listed winner Spirit Raiser. Sire progressed into top-class sprinter, won King's Stand Stakes as a Four-Year-Old, runner-up as a Five-Year-Old. **No AW Speed Figure yet**. The yard are just 4 from 66 with their Two-Year-Old debutantes so far this year. This one doesn't jump out of the page at me. <u>Advice:</u> **Definitely worth a market check but percentage call for me is to leave.**

CONCLUSION

This won't take much winning at all and it wouldn't take a world beater of a newcomer to take it, the most likely in My Opinion is **TWO DESSERTS** unless the market speaks strongly in favour of any of the other 3 (all 3 are from gambling yards). Of those with experience I would be shocked and worried where connections will go after this if **TURBO TIGER** doesn't go close but with the yard's Two-Year-Olds 0 from 64 in non-handicaps, I would want at least 6/1 before being tempted.
