- Two-Year-Old Geldings have just a 4.15% strike rate on debut in mixed sex races up to and including June
- May foals have a poor record

WATCH MY TRACER (IRE) - No Going Rating yet. *Two-Year-Old April Gelding out of Heavenly Angel by Dandy Man * George Scott/Daniel Muscutt, Previous Runs 0, Cost 75,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Dam now a Nine-Year-Old, was a 7-race maiden, placed over 7f as a Two-Year-Old. First foal in 2019 has produced 2 individual winner(s) over 5f and 6f. Sire: now a Twenty-Year-Old, useful Two-Year-Old, High-Class Sprinter as a Three to Six-Year-Old, including King's Stand runner-up as a Four-Year-Old. No Going Speed Figure. Related to a moderate mid-season Two-Year-Old winner. Progeny have a 100% Winners To Runners Ratio as of 2023. I would be disappointed if good enough to win this with just 3 winning Two-Year-Old debutantes and an Average debut Performance Figure of just 51.

JUMEIRAH BREEZE (IRE) - No Going Rating yet. *Two-Year-Old March Filly out of Rajmahal by Kessaar * George Margaron/Robert Havlin, Previous Runs 0, Cost 155,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Dam now a Twenty Two-Year-Old, is an unraced daughter of Indian Ridge. First foal in 2005 has produced 4 individual winner(s) over 5f to 8f. Sire: now a Seven-Year-Old, High-Class Juvenile, dual 6f Group winner, including Group 2 Mill Reef Stakes and Group 3 Sirenia Stakes (AW). No Going Speed Figure. Progeny have an 80% Winners To Runners Ratio, 100% as Two-Year-Olds as of 2023. Related to several Two-Year-Old winners including on debut and to Geometric who won twice including in Listed Company over 5f and placed in Group 3 Company over 6f as a Two-Year-Old but the yard have a poor record with their Two-Year-Olds on debut, with only 4 winners from 136 runners and 0 from 51 since the end of 2013 and an Average debut Performance Figure of just 56.

MACEDONIAN KING (IRE) - Turf Rating 28, Rating Rank 2, Race Type Speed Rank 2 *Two-Year-Old March Colt out of Concra Girl by Unfortunately * Amy Murphy/Stefano Cherchi, Previous Runs 1, Cost €24,000 as a Yearling. Dam now a Thirteen-Year-Old, was a four-race maiden. First foal in 2017 has produced 1 individual winner(s) over 8½f. Sire: now an Eight-Year-Old, Champion Two-Year-Old in France, won Prix Morny, won 6f Group 3 Renaissance Stakes as a Three-Year-Old. 86 Speed Figure. He was supported on debut at Beverley in April but was never involved and looked to have regressed on his second start at Windsor. Hard to make a case for judged on previous runs.

STATE OF DESIRE - No Going Rating yet. *Two-Year-Old February Colt out of Desirous by Frankel * Charlie Appleby/William Buick, Previous Runs 0, Cost 400,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Dam now a Seven-Year-Old, was 2 from 10, winning over 7f on her final run as a Two-Year-Old and over 8f on her first run as a Three-Year-Old. First foal in 2016. Sire: now a Fifteen-Year-Old, Highest-ever rated racehorse By Rprs, unbeaten 10-Time Group 1 winner. No Going Speed Figure. The obvious one but surely bred for further in time and Charlie Appleby hasn't really excelled at this track with his Two-Year-Olds on debut with just 2 winners from 11 qualifiers since 2020 but 8 of those 11 either won or were placed. On Average his Two-Year-Old debutantes run to around 76, 79 at Yarmouth and 78 with the progeny of Frankel whose Two-Year-Olds are just 2 from 14 on debut over 6f since 2020

AMERICAN TALE - Turf Rating 62, **Rating Rank 1, Race Type Speed Rank 1** *Two-Year-Old April Colt out of Taleteller by Expert Eye * Brian Meehan/Kevin Stott, Previous Runs 1, Cost 15,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Dam now a Twelve-Year-Old, was a 6-race maiden over 6f to 7f. First foal in 2017 has produced 1 individual winner(s) over 6f and 7f. Sire: now an Eight-Year-Old, High-Class Two-Year-Old, including Vintage Stakes, won Breeders' Cup Mile as Three-Year-Old. 87 Speed Figure. He wasn't unsupported on debut at Newbury in April but was very green in the preliminaries and could not get involved following a sluggish start, that does look a promising maiden that has produced 2 possibly decent subsequent winners.

EL BODON (IRE) - No Going Rating yet. *Two-Year-Old May Colt out of Flawless Jewel by Churchill * Jane Chapple-Hyam/Marco Ghiani, Previous Runs 0, Cost 150,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Dam now a Seven-Year-Old, was raced exclusively as a Two-Year-Old winning on her second of 4 starts over 5f. First foal in 2020 has produced 1 individual winner(s) over 5f. Sire: now a Nine-Year-Old, Champion Two-Year-Old Colt in Europe and dual Guineas Winner as a Three-Year-Old. No Going Speed Figure. Bred to be Speedy and Precocious, related to Pillow Talk who won a Two-Year-Old Listed Event over 5f on her second start as a Two-Year-Old.

JIMMY SPEAKING - No Going Rating yet. *Two-Year-Old April Gelding out of Ever After by Territories * Chris Dwyer/Lewis Edmunds, Previous Runs 0, Cost Unknown. Dam now a Ten-Year-Old, was a twice-raced maiden over 12½f. First foal in 2019. Sire: now an Eleven-Year-Old, Won Prix Jean Prat, second In 2,000 Guineas, Family Of Street Cry/Shamardal. No Going Speed Figure. Current progeny are generally poor and I would be shocked if good enough to win this on debut with an Average debut Performance Figure of just 56 and just 2 winning Two-Year-Old debutantes from 86 qualifiers.

MART - No Going Rating yet. *Two-Year-Old February Colt out of Adorn by Dark Angel * Michael Bell/Hector Crouch, Previous Runs 0, Cost 130,000 Guineas as a Yearling. Dam was rated 105 now a Seventeen-Year-Old, was 1 from 7, winning over 6f on her second start as a Two-Year-Old. First foal in 2011 has produced 4 individual winner(s) over 5f and 6f. Sire: now an Eighteen-Year-Old, Top-Class Two-Year-Old, including Mill Reef & Middle Park Stakes, retired Sound as a Two-Year-Old, Leading Sire Of Sprinters. No Going Speed Figure. Progeny have an 80% Winners To Runners Ratio as of 2023. He is bred to be a decent sprinter, related to Ornate who won and was placed in Group 2 Company over 5f as a Two-Year-Old and Saayer who was 3 from 5 as a Two-Year-Old over 5f and 6f including in Group 2 Company. The yard won this with a similarly bred January colt on debut in 2019 running to a Performance Figure of 79 but was their last Two-Year-Old winner making debut over 6f. The yard don't get too many Two-Year-Olds to win on debut with just 9 from 109 qualifiers since 2020 and all were 10/1 or less.

KHAMSIN (USA) - No Going Rating yet. *Two-Year-Old April Colt out of Street Love by Flatter * David Simcock/Jamie Spencer, Previous Runs 0, Cost Unknown. Dam now a Nine-Year-Old, is an unraced daughter of a US Grade 1 winner over 6f and 7f. First foal in 2019. Sire: now a Twenty Four-Year-Old, minor 7f-9f winner on dirt As a Two and Three-Year-Old, died as a Twenty-Three-Year-Old. No Going Speed Figure. Current progeny are generally poor. The yard do get two-Year-Old debutante winners at this track but his would be the yards first ever Two-Year-Old debutante winner before June and their first before July since 2016.

STATE OF DESIRE does have his own negatives but he could just be much better than these, I thought **EL BODON** was the interesting one to possibly take him on with. There doesn't really appear to be any other lurking newcomers unless Mr Bell's is supported. Brian Meehan's **AMERICAN TALE** looks the likely improver as he was behind Matters Most who has run to around 88 since and Succession who has run to around 82 and he ran some mid-race sectionals that suggested he is better than he has shown.
