### 1:25 - 1M4F NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 2) (3YO)

 Draw/Pace

Only 4 runners so pace and draw not hugely important here...

#### TRENDS/STATS/NOTES/POINTERS/FORM

#### PURSUIT OF LOVE (C Appleby)

Charlie Appleby holds some really strong stats at Haydock with similar types...

**C Appleby | Haydock Novice races | Males | SP <6/1 = (since 2018) 19/35 | 54% S/R | +£21.10 – W&P 28/35 | 80% S/R – 23% above exp**

Appleby also has strong stats with similar LTO winning 3yo's...

**C Appleby | Novice races restricted to 3yo's | Jan-Apr | SP 3/1 or less | WON LTO = 25/39 | 64% S/R | +£16.60 – W&P 32/39 | 82% S/R – 28% above exp**

#### RAVENSPIRE (K Burke)

Burke has some solid stats with similar LTO winning 3yo's...

**K Burke | 3yo's in Novice races | 2<sup>nd</sup> career start | same or up no more than 1f | SP 4/1 or less | WON LTO = 10/17 | 59% S/R | +£9.31 – W&P 15/17 | 88% S/R – 34% above exp**

#### FINAL THOUGHTS...

I've no desire to get involved in a 4-runner novice race... odds-on fav **PURSUIT OF LOVE** does look the most likely winner, but he's priced up accordingly... the Karl Burke stats for **RAVENSPIRE** do, however, suggest he's a definite player in this contest...

## **2:00 – 1M FILLIES NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 4) (3YO)**

### **Draw/Pace**

*Positive to be on or near the pace over this trip at Haydock (on the likely ground and field size)... no major pos/neg when it comes to the draw...*

*Limited starts for the field so hard to determine the likely pace with any confidence... **CHIMES OF THUNDER (stall 2)** did front-run on her only start to date so she's a potential for early pace-setting duties...*

### **TRENDS/STATS/NOTES/POINTERS/FORM**

#### **SYMBOL OF MAJESTY (J Gosden)**

*The Gosden's have some solid stats (from limited numbers) in similar types of races at Haydock...*

**J&T Gosden | Haydock 3yo Maiden/Novice races | SP <3/1 = 7111311212 (6/10, 2p | +£4.46)**

*They also hold solid stats with LTO winners in 3yo Novice races...*

**J&T Gosden | Turf 3yo Novice races in Apr-June | Favs | DSLR 240 or less | WON LTO = 12/16 | 75% S/R | +£8.42 – W&P 15/16 | 94% S/R – 40% above exp**

#### **FINAL THOUGHTS...**

*Hard to find anything strong on the stats for any of the field bar the fav, **SYMBOL OF MAJESTY**... like the first race, however, she is priced up accordingly...*

## **2:35 - 7F HANDICAP (CLASS 2) (4YO+)**

### **Draw/Pace**

*No major positives on running styles at this trip (on the likely ground and field size) but a small negative to race held-up... on the draw side of things the middle third of the draw can be a tricky place to break from, possibly the chance of being squeezed at the bend causing some early congestion for those in the middle...*

*No blast away front-runners in the field, so a change this could be run at a slow/false pace... **SARAB STAR (Stall 11) and CERULEAN BAY (10)** are potential early pace angles, although neither are guaranteed front-runners...*

### **TRENDS/STATS/NOTES/POINTERS/FORM**

#### **COSI BELLO (C Fellowes)**

*Charlie Fellowes has some solid Haydock stats with similar types...*

**C Fellowes | Haydock 7f-1m4f Hcps | 3yo-4yo's | 1+ Hcp start = 10/24 | 42% S/R | +£36.91 – W&P 12/24 | 50% S/R – 116% above exp**

*Finished 4<sup>th</sup> LTO in a big field straight track handicap at Ascot, running well from a poor draw (I noted him as a Badly Drawn Horse to keep an eye on in future starts)... 5 of first 7 home were drawn in stall 9+, COSI BELLO was drawn in stall 2... 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> have all won races since...*

#### **MARSHAM (K Burke)**

*Goes well under these conditions...*

**6f-7f | Listed level or less = 4/11, 4p - all 4 career wins**

*Unexposed in handicap company after only 3 previous starts in handicaps... all previous handicap starts came on A/W... handicap form of... 1/3, 1p... win came off OR 102 and place came off OR 110 (runs here off OR 104 and has a 5lb claimer on top)...*

*Karl Burke also has some solid stats in similar races at Haydock...*

**K Burke | Haydock C2-C4 Hcps in Apr-May | 6f-1m | GB or IRE bred horses with 1+ career win | DSLR 42 or less = 12/40 | 30% S/R | +£102.36 – W&P 17/40 | 43% S/R – 154% above exp**


 **KORKER (K Burke)** 🤔

*Handicap Sleeper who goes well under these conditions...*

**C2 or less (35k or less) | OR 102 or less | DSLR 10-45 = 6/11, 4p - all 6 career wins**

*All his wins have come at 5f and this is his first try over further than 6f (so distance an unknown)... Haydock form of 3621 (1/4, 2p)...*

*Fits the same Karl Burke angle as MARSHAM...*

 **FINAL THOUGHTS...**

**COSI BELLO** went in my tracker as BDH after his last run and looks a horse with plenty more to come this season, he could be a good bit below his handicap ceiling still and he should be a big player in this...

**MARSHAM** is interesting tackling a handicap on turf for the first time and looks a shade over-priced at around the 11/1-12/1 mark...

## **3:10 – 1M2.5F HANDICAP (CLASS 4) (4YO+)**

### **Draw/Pace**

*A slight positive to be on or near the pace over this trip at Haydock (on the likely ground and field size) although ultimately you see a decent spread of winners from all running styles... No major drawn positives or negatives at the trip (on the likely ground and field size)...*

*Potential a few that could go to the front and set the pace here, with the runners drawn in **stalls 1, 2, 3 and 4** all showing recent signs of front-running... between them they should set a solid early gallop...*

### **TRENDS/STATS/NOTES/POINTERS/FORM**

#### **TED LE SAUX (A Balding)**

*Handicap debutant who gets the assistance of William Buick in the saddle, Buick holding strong stats in similar types of races at Haydock...*

**W Buick | Haydock | C3 or less | 1m2.5f – 1m6f | Good+ = 15/35 | 43% S/R | +£41.59 – W&P 19/35 | 54% S/R – 39% above exp**

#### **DUE TO HENRY (E J Houghton) 🙄**

*A Handicap Sleeper who gets his Prime Conditions to shoot for here...*

**OR 84 or less | C4 or less | fields of 10 or less = 12141 (3/5, 1p - all 3 career wins)**

### **FINAL THOUGHTS...**

*Looks a bit of a fiddly race from a betting perspective... **TED LE SAUX** is very much unexposed but Balding's record with 4yo's on Hcp debut (when racing on turf) does worry me a little – 4/52, 10p | 45% below exp...*

***DUE TO HENRY** does go well under these conditions and he is now on his lowest handicap mark, he has been poor on recent starts and it's hard to know if those runs were just due to not having PC/being too high in the handicap or if something else was the cause (niggly injury... out of form... yard...)... there's enough juice in his price, however, to take an each-way dart to find out if having his PC will see him show a bit more life today...*

## **3:45 – 1M HANDICAP (CLASS 4) (3YO)**

### **Draw/Pace**

*A positive to be on or near the pace over this trip at Haydock (on the likely ground and field size)... Slight positive to be drawn MIDDLE to LOW at this trip at Haydock (on the likely ground and field size)...*

*A few in here that could make the pace... **GO RIMBAUD (Stall 3)** may be the one most likely to try and go from the front... **DUNKELD DREAMER (Stall 9)** is another who may be on or very close to the pace as well... as could **SEE BLUE (Stall 4)**.. and there should be a strong enough gallop at play in this....*

### **TRENDS/STATS/NOTES/POINTERS/FORM**

#### **GO RIMBAUD (J & T Gosden)**

*The Gosden's have some solid stats at Haydock in similar races to this with similar types of horses...*

**J&T Gosden | Haydock 3yo Hcps in Apr-Aug | 3+ career starts | DSLR 10-49 = 13/33 | 39% S/R | +£68.48 – W&P 19/33 | 58% S/R – 95% above exp**

*The Gosden's also have strong stats at Haydock with similar LTO winners...*

**J&T Gosden | Haydock 7f-1m6f | NO Headgear or TT | WON LTO = 25/60 | 42% S/R | +£43.24 – W&P 38/60 | 63% S/R – 46% above exp**

#### **STRENGTH OF SPIRIT (K Burke)**


*Karl Burke has some solid stats in similar races at Haydock...*

**K Burke | Haydock C2-C4 Hcps in Apr-May | 6f-1m | GB or IRE bred horses with 1+ career win | DSLR 42 or less = 12/40 | 30% S/R | +£102.36 – W&P 17/40 | 43% S/R – 154% above exp**

#### **DUNKELD DREAMER (K Burke)**

*Karl Burke has some solid stats in similar races at Haydock...*

**K Burke | Haydock C2-C4 Hcps in Apr-May | 6f-1m | GB or IRE bred horses with 1+ career win | DSLR 42 or less = 12/40 | 30% S/R | +£102.36 – W&P 17/40 | 43% S/R – 154% above exp**

 **FINAL THOUGHTS...**

*A tight little contest this but the stats pull me towards the Gosden runner **GO RIMBAUD**...*

***DUNKELD DREAMER** is possibly over-priced and the stats for his jockey – P L Jamin - at Haydock in Handicaps over 1m or less do catch my eye... 8/25, 2p \ +£32.97... and he looks worth an E/W play alongside the Gosden runner...*

## **4:20 – 6f HANDICAP (CLASS 5) (3YO)**

### **Draw/Pace**

*No major pace position positive or negative over this trip at Haydock (on the likely ground and field size)... Very slight positive to be drawn in the MIDDLE third of the draw at this trip at Haydock (on the likely ground and field size)...*

***ADALIDA (Stall 3)** may be the one who is right at the head of the field in the early stages... **CALL ME BY MY NAME (5) & HOUNDHILL (6)** also can be on or near the pace from the off, which may give a small positive to those drawn middle to low, being that is where the early pace horses look to be breaking from...*

### **TRENDS/STATS/NOTES/POINTERS/FORM**

#### **FULL GAS (K Ryan)**

*Kevin Ryan holds solid stats with similar types in races like this at Haydock...*

**K Ryan | Haydock C3-C5 3yo Hcps | Male horses with 1+ Hcp starts | Same or up in trip | DSLR 42 or less = 13/59 | 22% S/R | +£84.39 – W&P 27/59 | 46% S/R – 51% above exp**

#### **FINAL THOUGHTS...**

*Not much to go on here on my stats/notes... **FULL GAS** is trading at around double figures, however, and with most books paying 4-places it's possibly worth having an E/W stab at the Kevin Ryan runner...*

## **4:55 – 6f HANDICAP (CLASS 5) (4YO+)**

### **Draw/Pace**

*No major pace position positive or negative over this trip at Haydock (on the likely ground and field size)... Very slight positive to be drawn in the MIDDLE third of the draw at this trip at Haydock (on the likely ground and field size)...*

**ANDALPROFIT (Stall 9)** looks the main early pace angle in this... **PUNCHBOWL FLYER (8)** also likes to be right up there from the off, which may give a small positive to those drawn high to middle, being that is where the early pace horses look to be breaking from...

### **TRENDS/STATS/NOTES/POINTERS/FORM**

#### **FISCAL POLICY (R Carr)** 🤔

*A Handicap Sleeper with his PC to shoot for...*

**OR 77 or less | 5f-6f Hcps | Apr-Nov | fields of 11 or less = 8/14, 3p – all 8 career wins**

*Jo Mason holds some solid stats when riding for Ruth Carr under similar circumstances...*

**R Carr/J Mason | C4 or less Hcps | <1m | Horses aged 4yo+ | DSLR <21 = 18/78 | 23% S/R | +£140.21 – W&P 40/78 | 51% S/R – 79% above exp**

#### **GOOD EARTH (M Herrington)** 🤔

*A Handicap Sleeper with his PC to shoot for...*

**OR 81 or less | Turf C4 or less Hcps | DSLR 6-20 = 9/21, 8p – 9 of 12 turf wins**

### **FINAL THOUGHTS...**

*The two Handicap Sleepers - **FISCAL POLICY & GOOD EARTH** - both sit near the head of the market and it makes sense to cover them both, given they both have their conditions to shoot for...*
