2:10 - 6F APPRENTICE HANDICAP (CLASS 6) (3YO)

DRAW/PACE

Positive to front-run over this trip at Catterick (on the likely ground and field size)...small negative to be held-up over this trip at Catterick (on the likely ground and field size)...

*The likely early pace should come from **THE TUNGUSKA EVENT (Stall 4)** and he could get a solo early lead in this...*

THE TUNGUSKA EVENT (JJ Quinn)

John Quinn has some solid stats with similar types in similar races to this...

JJ Quinn | C4 or less Apprentice Hcps at Yorkshire tracks | 6f+ | Same or down 1 class level | DSLR 4-45 = 14/63 | 22% S/R | +£52.75 – W&P 25/63 | 40% S/R – 71% above exp

YACHTSMAN (J Morland)

Jack Morland has been profitable to follow with similar horses returning off similar break periods...

J Morland | C4 or less Hcps | Geldings | DSLR 25 or less | SP 14/1 or less = 18/60 | 30% S/R | +£70.15 – W&P 26/60 | 43% S/R

FINAL THOUGHTS...

THE TUNGUSKA EVENT comes here off two career best efforts on his last two starts and his recently applied visor (stays on here) does look to have unlocked improvement from him... the fact he could get an easy lead out front here is an added bonus and he looks the one to be on...

2:40 – 6F MAIDEN FILLIES STAKES (CLASS 4) (3YO+)

DRAW/PACE

No major positive or negative over this trip at Catterick (on the likely ground and field size)...

Pace

Positive to front-run over this trip at Catterick (on the likely ground and field size)...small negative to be held-up over this trip at Catterick (on the likely ground and field size)...

*From what we've seen of these runners so far in their career **GOT THE BOOTY (Stall 6)** and possibly **LADY GORMIRE (1)** will be the ones on or very near the early pace in this one...*

ROUANE (A Balding)

Balding doesn't send many to Catterick but has some tight stats with similar types...

A Balding | Catterick | 3yo's | 2-4 career starts | SP10/1 or less = 212221122 (3/9, 5p | +£11.38)

I can leave this one alone...



3:10 – 6F HANDICAP (CLASS 5) (4YO+)

DRAW/PACE

Draw

Positive to be drawn in Q1 over this trip at Catterick (on the likely ground and field size)... **small negative to be drawn in Q4** (on the likely ground and field size)...

Pace

Positive to front-run over this trip at Catterick (on the likely ground and field size)...**small negative to be held-up over this trip at Catterick** (on the likely ground and field size)...

INGLEBY ARCH (Stall 1) and possibly **SAFARI DREAM (7)** look the ones most likely to front run in this, although there isn't an out and out blast away front runner in the field, so may possibly only be an even early pace at play...

SAFARI DREAM (B R Millman)

Roger Millman has some strong stats with similar LTO winners...

R Millman | Hcps over <1m | Horses aged 3yo+ | SP 5/1 or less | DSLR 7 or less | WON LTO = 12/24 | 50% S/R | +£13.09 – W&P 19/24 | 79% S/R – 48% above exp

FISCAL POLICY (R Carr) 🤔

Handicap Sleeper who goes well under these conditions...

OR 77 or less | 5f-6f Hcps | Apr-Nov | fields of 11 or less = 8/16, 5p – all 8 career wins

INGLEBY ARCH (A Nicholls) 🤔

Handicap Sleeper who goes well under these conditions...

Hcps | OR 73 or less | May-July = 1111 (4/4 – all 4 career wins)

EVOCATIVE SPARK (J Riches) 🤔

Handicap Sleeper who goes well under these conditions...

OR 78 or less | 6f-1m (round a bend) | carrying 9-05 or less = 7/18, 6p - all 7 career wins (Carries 9-06 here)

 **FINAL THOUGHTS...**

INGLEBY ARCH is unbeaten under these conditions and has a good draw to attack from... his trainer- Adrian Nicholls – also holds some strong stats under similar conditions... A Nicholls | Catterick 5f-7f in May-Oct | C5 or less | DSLR 10-42 | SP 14/1 or less = 9/22, 2p | +£46.76... and this looks a good spot for the 5yo to land his 5th career victory...

3:40 – 1M4F HANDICAP (CLASS 4) (4YO+)

***PERCY'S DAYDREAM (Stall 4)** may well get a solo lead on the front end here, with **ANALOGICAL (1)** the only other that may have interest in being up or near the pace in the early stages...*

D O'Meara | Catterick 1m4f or less | C3 or less | Same/down no more than 1f/upon more than 2f | SP 4/1 or less | DSLR 30 or less | WON LTO= 14/28 | 50% S/R | +£23.53 – W&P 20/28 | 71% S/R

FINAL THOUGHTS...

Think I'll leave this one alone... looks a bit fiddly...



4:15 – 7F HANDICAP (CLASS 6) (3YO)

DRAW/PACE

Small negative to be drawn in Q1 (on the likely ground and field size)...

Pace

Small positive to front-run over this trip at Catterick (on the likely ground and field size)...small negative to be held-up over this trip at Catterick (on the likely ground and field size)...

*The early pace looks likely to come from one or a mix of **MUSICALSOLDIER (Stall 1)**, **LOPE Y LINDA (7)** & **SOUTH COAST STAR (8)** although none of them will possibly be blasting away in the lead, so maybe just an even early gallop at play...*

MUSICAL SOLDIER (O Sangster)

Ollie Sangster has some very strong stats with similar types to this...

O Sangster | Male 2yo-3yo's | DSLR 45 or less | SP 4/1 or less | WON LTO= 16/21 | 76% S/R | +£16.44 – W&P 17/21 | 81% S/R – 54% above exp

HOODWINK (T Easterby)

Tim Easterby has solid stats with similar types to this at Catterick...

T Easterby | 5f-7f Catterick 3yo Hcps | Male horses = 22/86 | 26% S/R | +£81.64 – W&P 35/86 | 41% S/R – 60% above exp

FINAL THOUGHTS...

*I'll take a chance on **HOODWINK** here, who is dropping back in trip to 7f for the first time since his Novice days... Tim Easterby & Sean Kirrane have some solid stats at Catterick with similar types... T Easterby/S Kirrane | Catterick C4 or less | Good or softer | Male horses | SP 14/1 or less = 12/36, 5p | +£43.87... the added bonus being that Kirrane is 1 from 1 on horse and is the only jockey to have won on the horse to date...*

4:50 – 7F HANDICAP (CLASS 6) (4YO+)

DRAW/PACE

Draw

Small negative to be drawn in Q1 (on the likely ground and field size)...

Pace

Small positive to front-run over this trip at Catterick (on the likely ground and field size)...small negative to be held-up over this trip at Catterick (on the likely ground and field size)...

FILEY BEACH (Stall 2) may be the main pace angle here and he might manage to get to the front and control things as he likes from stall 2... SAISONS D'OR (Stall 4) is the other who could also be up near the front end in the early stages...

FILEY BEACH (Mrs R Carr) 🥱

Handicap Sleeper who goes well under these conditions...

(Since with R Carr) OR 54 or less | DSLR 14 or less | 7f = 1161 (3/4 – all 3 career wins)

SAISONS D'OR (J O'Keefe) 🥱

Handicap Sleeper who goes well under these conditions...

OR 72 or less | C5 or less | 7f-7.5f | fields of 12 or less | Feb-Aug = 9/30, 7p – 9 of 12 career wins

EMERALD ARMY (Mrs R Carr) 🥱

Handicap Sleeper who goes well under these conditions...

OR 59 or less | C6 Hcps over 6f-7f | Carrying 9-06 or less | 0-4 starts last 90-day = 312312134 (3/9, 5p – all 3 career wins)

FINAL THOUGHTS...

This could be between the two Ruth Carr runners...

FILEY BEACH was a good winner of an apprentice Handicap LTO over CD and gets to run off the same mark here... it was a 'rated 0-65 race' LTO but this is a 'rated 46-60 race' and does look an 'easier' contests... and looks a good spot for him to bag his third CD win from his 4th CD start...

EMERALD ARMY is also one I want on my side... he ran a decent enough race at Redcar LTO given it's not a track that really suits him (now 0/4, 0p at Redcar) and he was the best of those ridden held-up/midfield, in a race that suited those that front-ran/chased the leader... he gets his PC here and looks a player...

5:27 – 7F FILLIES HANDICAP (CLASS 5) (3YO+)

DRAW/PACE

Draw

Small negative to be drawn in Q1 (on the likely ground and field size)...

Pace

Small positive to front-run over this trip at Catterick (on the likely ground and field size)...small negative to be held-up over this trip at Catterick (on the likely ground and field size)...

*Could be a strong early pace at play here, with **TEN SIXTY SIX (Stall 4) & VELVET RHYTHM (2)** likely to be out on the front from the off, and **IN A HURRY (9)**, **HOMESTRAIT (6) & THEHUNNEBELLEGACY (7)** likely to sitting on their tails... and the possibly won't be hanging about in the early stages of this one...*

TRENDS/STATS/NOTES/POINTERS/FORM

BLUFFERONTHEBUS (C Lidster) 🤖

Handicap Sleeper who goes well under these conditions...

OR 64 or less | 6f-1m Hcps | fields of <12 | DSLR 7-42 = 5/9, 1p - 5 of 6 career wins

HOMESTRAIT (B Ellison)

Goes well under these conditions...

Turf | May-Aug | DSLR 25 or less = 12122 (2/5,3p – both career wins)

FINAL THOUGHTS...

HOMESTRAIT ran not far off his best over a trip (6f) just short of his best in a race slightly better than this at Catterick LTO and he should be able to get a good sit just off the pace-setters in this, before making his move in the final couple furlongs, and he's the one I want to be on in this closing contest...
