Pace/Draw thoughts...

Pace: **BOLSTER (Stall 16) & NOBLE HORIZON (8)** look the two most likely to set the early pace, with **TWISTING PHYSICS (6)** likely sitting just behind them... there should be at least an even/solid early pace at play in this...

Draw: This has been a little bit of a tricky race for those drawn in Q1 of the draw, with only 2 of the last 12 renewals being won by a horse drawn in Q1 (42% below exp)... if we stretch back to the last 29 renewals Q1 has only won 3-times (overall stats of 3/110 - 67% below exp) and I'd have it as a small negative to be drawn in Q1 here...

JAMES DOYLE holds solid stats at Goodwood in similar races... **J Doyle** | Goodwood 7f+ Handicaps | June-October | Horses with 0-13 Hcp starts | NOT Handicaps restricted to 3yo's = 11/47 | 23% S/R | +£57.49 BFLSP – W&P 23/47 | 49% S/R - 40% above exp | E/W = +£30.80... **QUAI DE BETHUNE** meets that angle here...

IAN WILLIAMS holds solid stats at Goodwood in similar races... **I Williams** | Goodwood 4yo+ Hcps | horses aged 5yo or 6yo | 1-5 starts last 90-days = 10/27 | 37% S/R | +£53.21 – W&P 16/27 | 59% S/R – 113% above exp | E/W = +£59.24... **NIGHT BREEZE** meets that angle here...

Conclusion/Current Thoughts...

Thoughts on trend toppers...

YABHER (Stall 14) disappointed at York LTO but his best form has come away from LH tracks (he's 0/4, 1p on LH tracks) and that could have been the reason for the down the field effort... he's 1 from 1 over this CD and goes well under the general conditions... **Good+ | RH/Straight track = 11181 (4/5 – all 4 career wins)...**

PAROLE D'ORO (10) finished 4th over a straight 1m at Newmarket LTO in a race that's been working out well enough so far (future form of 2W, 2P from 5 subsequent runs)... 1 from 11 in career to date and 1st time CPs go on to try and squeeze something from him... might be at his best in the second half of the season and off similar breaks to this... **July-Oct | DSLR 16-60 = 42021 (1/5, 2p)...**

TWISTING PHYSICS (6) winner LTO by a neck at Windsor and is another who may be at his best at this time of the year... **June-Nov form = 12114 (3/5, 1p – all 3 career wins)...**

Thoughts on others...

BOLSTER (Stall 16) Handicap Sleeper who goes well under these conditions... **OR 105 or less | C2 level or less = 1211011 (5/7, 1p – 5 of 6 career wins)...** ran 4th in this last year off a 5lb higher mark and could have finished closer but for being hampered around the 2f pole...

NIGHT BREEZE (11) has been in decent form this season so far and goes well under these conditions... **Turf 1m1f-1m4f | Apr-Aug | DSLR <31 = 6/11, 4p – all 6 career wins...**

QUAI DE BETHUNE (12) well-beaten both starts this season but they've both come on LH tracks and he's possibly best on RH tracks... **2/4 on RH tracks compared to 0/4 on LH tracks...** still unexposed in handicaps after only 4 previous Hcp starts...

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My play(s)...

I like the following two from the shortlist...

YABHER (W Haggas) happy to forgive his run at York LTO based on him possibly being better this way round and his win over this CD on seasonal debut suggested his mark of OR 102 is still below his ceiling...

TWISTING PHYSICS (O Cole) still relatively unexposed after just 8 runs, only 5 in handicaps, and Dubawi offspring aged 3yo-5yo hold solid stats over the 1m2f-1m3f Goodwood trips in July-Aug... 12/46, 8p | +£37.74 – 68% above exp...

This was changed from a 4yo+ Hcp to a 3yo+ Hcp last year and that's enough to make what were previously strong Race Trends null and void... so no Race Trends for this... but plenty other angles/trends/stats/notes we can use to dig into the race...

Pace/Draw thoughts...

Pace: Potential for plenty early pace in this, with possible front runners drawn in **Stalls 23, 21, 17, 16, 13, 8, 7, 5 & 4** and this should be run at a strong early gallop...

Draw: Looking at all 5f races run at Glorious Goodwood on Good or quicker ground and with fields of 15+ returns 31 races... when you split them by draw quarters the figures are... **Q1 = 9 winners (30% of races) | Q2 = 9 (30%) | Q3 = 9 (30%) | Q4 = 4 (13%)**... so a small positive to Q1, Q2 & Q3... and possibly a small negative to Q4...

DAVID O'MEARA holds solid stats in similar races at Goodwood... **D O'Meara** | **C2 3yo+ hcps** | **4yo-7yo's** | **NO Claiming jockey** | **DSLRL <26 = (since 2020) 10/36** | **28% S/R** | **+£113.36 – W&P 19/36** | **53% S/R – 155% above exp...** **ZIGGYS TRITON & TOCA MADERA** meet those stats here...

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Conclusion/Current Thoughts...

NAANAS SPARKLE (Stall 6) meets a 'previously won at Glorious Goodwood' angle I have plugged in... **Glorious Goodwood Class 1 & 2 races** | **4yo-9yo Colts and Geldings** | **1-6 runs in current season** | **Same or up no more than 4f from previous start** | **Previously WON at Glorious Goodwood = (since 2016) 20/77** | **26% S/R** | **+£148.50 BFLSP - W&P 31/77** | **40% S/R - 72% above exp...** winner of 2 of his 3 starts this season... steps up above C3 level for first time here...

TATTERSTALL (13) also meets the 'previously won at Glorious Goodwood' angle... strong form line under today's conditions... **5f on Und/Very Und/AW tracks** | **May-July = 211113 (4/6, 2p – all 4 career wins)**... only 2lbs above his last and highest winning mark...

VINTAGE CLARETS (9) Handicap Sleeper who goes well under these conditions... **OR 94 or less** | **5f** | **NOT Seasonal debut = 10/24, 7p – all 10 career wins...**

TOCA MADERA (4) goes well under these conditions... **June-Aug** | **Good to Firm or quicker** | **DSLRL <26** | **Race worth 40k or less = 19131 (3/5, 1p – all 3 career wins)**... this only his 7th start for David O'Meara, and he could get more out of him yet...

ADRESTIA (24) finished 2nd in this last year off a 3lb higher mark and goes well under these conditions... **C2 or less** | **June-July** | **DSLRL <31 = 02111 (3/5, 1p – all 3 career wins)**...

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My play(s)...

This looks extremely competitive and I want to cover three of my shortlist...

TATTERSTALL (M Dods) has been in good form so far this season and posted his best RPR figure when winning at this meeting last year... his trainer – Michael Dods – holds some strong stats in class 2 sprints in July-Aug... **M Dods** | **5f-6f straight track C2 Hcps in July-Aug** | **3yo-6yo's** | **DSLRL 45 or less = (since 2017) 16/41, 8p** | **+£156.31 – E/W +£157.43...** and with his Prime Conditions to attack here I want him on my side...

VINTAGE CLARETS (R Fahey) has posted a couple of strong efforts on his last 2 starts and he's extremely well-handicapped on his best form... they could go quick in the early stages of this and that could tee things up for him as he tends to finish his races off strongly from his Held-Up/Midfield racing position...

TOCA MADERA (D O'Meara) David O'Meara seems to be getting a tune out of this 5yo since he picked him up from the Brian Meehan yard and the figure he posted when winning at Doncaster 3 starts back suggests OR 95 is a mark he can still defy... his 12th of 15 at Ascot LTO is easy to ignore as he's 0/7, 0p there and just doesn't seem to handle the track well... he finished 3rd over this CD at the 2024 Glorious meeting off a 1lb lower mark so he handles big field Goodwood sprints well and the drying ground will also be a positive for him...

Pace/Draw thoughts...

Pace: **WID (Stall 11)** looks a potential early pace angle here and she could get a solo lead out front... if she doesn't go to the front then there's a chance this will be slowly/falsely run in the early stages...

Draw: **Horses drawn in Q4 in this race have struggled a little**, winning only the one renewal and picking up only 4 additional places (61% below expectation)...

WILLIAM HAGGAS holds solid stats in similar Goodwood Handicaps... **W Haggas** | Goodwood 3yo+ Hcps | 0-7 Hcp starts | 0-2 Hcp wins = 21/63 | 33% S/R | +£132.54 – W&P 30/63 | 48% S/R – 75% above exp... **PROPOSAL** meets those stats here...

ROGER VARIAN holds solid stats in similar Goodwood Handicaps... **R Varian** | Goodwood 3yo+ Hcps over 7f-1m6f | July-Oct | 3yo-5yo | Same/Up 1/Down 1 or 2 class levels | 0-2 Hcps wins = 9/27 | 33% S/R | +£37.40 – W&P 17/27 | 63% S/R – E/W = +£45.39 – 90% above exp... **RUMBA NUMBA** meets those stats here...

Conclusion/Current Thoughts...

Thoughts on trend toppers...

JUST CALL ME ANGEL (Stall 10) 0/4, 0p above C4 level so far, although this is his first try at C3 level (0/4 record is at C2/Listed level)... both wins to date came over 7f so needs to prove 1m is within range...

ANNASTARZY (3) won last 3 starts, including over this CD 2 starts back... that Goodwood win and her win at Newbury LTO both been working out well so far... goes well under these conditions... **Hcps in May-July | DSLR <31 = 1118 (3/4 – all 3 career wins)**...

WID (11) winner at 3rd time of asking LTO at Carlisle, her first try over as far as a mile... Ralph Beckett holds some solid stats with Handicap debutants at Goodwood... **R Beckett | Goodwood 6f-1m3f Hcps | Hcp debutants | 0-1 career wins = (since 2013) 9/25, 3p | +£77.67 – 124% above exp...**

PROPOSAL (13) winner on seasonal debut at Doncaster in April but failed to back that up when beaten fav LTO on Hcp debut at Windsor...

Thoughts on others...

RUMBA NUMBA (Stall 14) finished 4th in this last year on Hcp debut off a 4lb lower mark... posted a decent 5th at Royal Ascot LTO in Kensington Palace Stakes over 1m, met traffic problems around 2f out that day and effort worth upgrading a touch on the bare form...

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My play(s)...

Another competitive contest... I'll cover two from my shortlist...

WID (R Beckett) has a few stats/trends positives on her side here and Beckett has his string rolling in good form this month, especially his 3yo's over trips <1m3f... 15/32 | 47% S/R | +£70.29 – W&P 19/32 | 59% S/R – 63% above exp...

ANNASTARZY (R Hannon) has ben progressing steady on recent starts and her jockey – Joe Leavy – gets on well with her (form of 1116) and there's every chance she'll continue on her upward curve here...

Only 5 previous renewals of this handicap so not one we can get a grip on yet via the Race Trends... plenty other angles/trends/stats/notes we can use to dig into the race with, however...

Pace/Draw thoughts...

Pace: **ANGEL SHARED (Stall 14)** may be the one to be right at the head of the pack from the off... but the likes of **ZEN DIVA (17)**, **CINQUE VERDE (15)** & **SHALLOW (10)** also tend to be on or very near the early pace and there should be some decent early pace at play in this...

Draw: Looking at where the potential early pace horses are drawn suggests there may be at least a small bias towards the middle to high numbers here, those drawn low/bottom-third don't look to have any obvious early pace horses to drag them along in the early stages...

STORMY IMPACT (Stall 18) Hcp Sleeper who goes well under the conditions... **OR 93 or less** | **C2 or less** | **DSLRL 42 or less** = 5411122 (3/7, 3p – all 3 career wins)...

SHALLOW (10) Handicap Sleeper who goes well under these conditions... **C3 or less** | **OR <82** | **6f** | Jan-July = 5/14, 6p - all 5 career wins...

ZEN DIVA (17) wide margin winner of her 2 starts this season and Ralph Beckett holds some solid stats with horses that won their last 2 starts... **R Beckett** | Turf Hcps in June-Nov | 3yo | at least 4lbs higher than last run | SP 9/1 or less | Won last 2 starts (last run a Hcp) = 22/59, 7p | +£30.42 – 31% above exp...

CINDY LOU WHO (2) 4yo with good form under the conditions... **May-Sept** | **DSLRL <31** | **NOT V Und tracks** | **W Carson riding** = 511121 (4/6, 1p – all 4 career wins)...

MACHADADORP (9) decent 2nd on hcp debut LTO and drops back to 6f for first time ... Balding holds solid stats with similar 3yo handicappers... **A Balding** | 3yo's in 3yo+ Turf fillies & mares Hcps over 1m3f or less | 1-2 previous Hcp starts | Top 5 finish LTO = 16/46 | 35% S/R | +£78.10 – W&P 22/46 | 48% S/R - 67% above exp...

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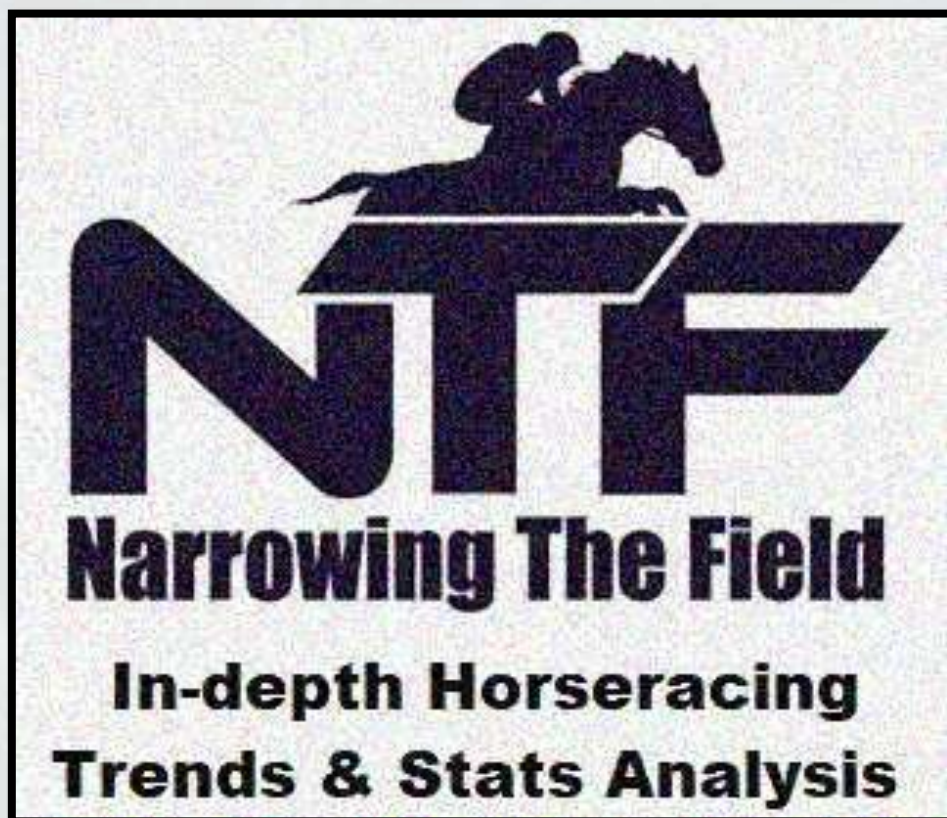
My play(s)...

I'll cover three in this...

ZEN DIVA (**R Beckett**) has looked good on her 2 starts this season and De Sousa coming on board for the first time is interesting, as he holds some solid stats when riding for Beckett under similar conditions... **R Beckett/SDS** | **C3-C6** | **2yo-3yo** | **Horses with 0-8 career starts** | **SP 10/1 or less** = 24/60, 12p | +£40.52... **ZEN DIVA** also meets those recent Beckett July stats I mentioned for *WID* in the previous race...

MACHADADORP (**A Balding**) is the least exposed runner in the field and Balding does well at track with similar types... **A Balding** | **Goodwood 5f-6f** | **C2-C4** | **Same or down 1f** | **SP <8/1** = (since 2021) 10/26, 6p | +£16.70...

STORMY IMPACT (**R Fahey**) ran as well as could be expected from a tricky draw LTO at Chester and form of that race does look strong... conditions in her favour here and she holds a solid form line at C3 level or less... 51122 (2/5, 2p)...



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
